

Acting Governor Kim Guadagno Orders Flags Lowered to Half-Staff in Honor of Fallen Military Serviceman

Trenton, NJ – Today, Acting Governor Kim Guadagno signed the following Executive Order:

Executive Order No. 91 – Ordering all State buildings to fly flags at half-staff on Wednesday, April 4, 2012 to honor the service and sacrifice of United States Marine Staff Sergeant Joseph D’Augustine, who was raised in Waldwick, entered the U.S. Marine Corps immediately upon graduating from Waldwick High School and was assigned to Camp Lejeune in North Carolina. Staff Sergeant D’Augustine tragically lost his life while supporting combat operations in Helmand Province, Afghanistan.
