Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

May nearly matched April's historic losses due to the COVID-19 pandemic as the region's total domestic and international air passenger volumes sank 97 percent year-over-year for the month, serving only 378,206 travelers (-12.151 million passengers). As in the month of April, the domestic sector (accounting for more than 60 percent of the region's total air passenger traffic) was responsible for the majority of the decline, down 7.72 million travelers (-96 percent). The international sector saw its volume plummet by 98.8 percent (down 4.431 million passengers). The region's total air freight volume continued its disappointing performance, down 33.1 percent as both the international and domestic cargo segments recorded double-digit plunges. The main driver of the 63,744-ton decline was the international sector's 50,444-ton shortfall (down 44.3 percent). With a 16.9 percent slump, domestic freight traffic experienced its second consecutive monthly double-digit tumble (down 13,300 tons).
