Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Regional passenger traffic growth increased 0.2 percent, split between flat domestic and 0.7 percent international growth. Scheduled seats fell 0.4 percent, with a 0.7 percent domestic decline and a 0.3 percent international gain. A4A traffic reported by U.S. flag airlines increased 0.2 percent overall, while ACI North American November traffic gained 0.9 percent. Regional freight decreased 9.5 percent, split between declines of 6 percent for domestic and 11.4 percent for international markets. Freight operations decreased 3.3 percent.
