Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

Following record accomplishments in January and February, the COVID-19 pandemic caused the region's total, domestic and international air passenger activity to sink by more than 50 percent year-over-year in the month of March. Total passenger volume plummeted by 55.2 percent (-6.479 million travelers). The domestic sector led with a 4.322-million passenger drop (-56 percent). International passenger traffic recorded a 53.7 percent slump (-2.157,324 travelers). The COVID-19 crisis also dealt an enormously heavy blow to our region's cargo performance, which has been negative since June 2019. Total cargo traffic recorded a 24.4 percent collapse (-47,892 tons). International cargo activity – accounting for 60 percent of the region's total freight volume – led with a 40,912-ton plunge (-33.1 percent). Domestic freight declined by 9.7 percent (-6,980 tons).
