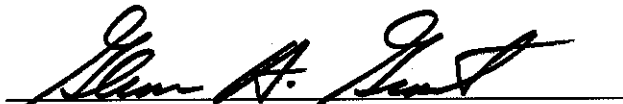


NOTICE TO THE BAR

CHANGE IN COURT HOURS FOR HUDSON COUNTY SUPERIOR COURT BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 3, 2014

Because of the impending long-term closure of the Pulaski Skyway to inbound traffic into Jersey City, effective Monday, March 3, 2014 the hours for the Hudson County Superior Court will be **from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m.** These revised court hours for Hudson County, which will be in effect until further notice, have been approved by the Chief Justice pursuant to Rule 1:30-3(a) and Directive #1-82.

While the official court hours for the Hudson Vicinage will be from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., the public will have full access to the court facilities in the Brennan Courthouse and the County Administration Building beginning at 9 a.m. Additionally, the public will have limited access beginning at 8:30 a.m. to the first floor of the County Administration Building (via the front door only) for Probation, Finance, and Special Civil Part matters.
