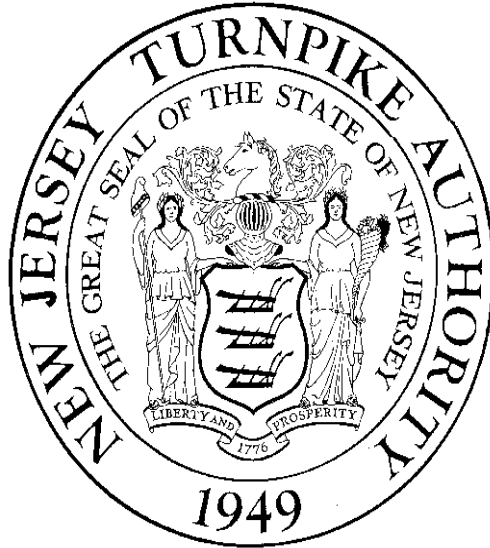

154-06-2019 **Authorization to Declare Surplus portions of New Jersey Turnpike Parcels 599X-1 and 599X-2 in Section 6, as Surplus to the Authority's Needs and to transfer these parcels to Conrail**

Amount: \$1,360,000.00 (Revenue to the Authority)

The subject parcel is approximately 1.625 acres of vacant land within the New Jersey Turnpike Right-of-Way at the rear of 156-202 Blanchard Street in the City of Newark, Essex County. Conrail is seeking to purchase approximately 1.077 acres and to create two (2) aerial easements over Authority property. These property interests have been valued at no less than \$1,360,000 and have been certified by the various departments as surplus to the Authority's needs. Authorization is sought to declare these parcels surplus for future conveyance to Conrail for fair market value.

155-06-2019 **New Jersey State Police ("NJSP") Request for Authorization for Direct Online Access to the E-ZPass Vector System Database**

The NJSP Troop D have requested direct access to the E-ZPass Database to enable more efficient verification of toll data. This access would replace the long utilized and burdensome system of using telephone communications and would improve efficiency and accuracy of E-ZPass information review. The proposed new protocol would be the subject of a 1-year pilot program all governed by a strict set of Guidelines limiting access to NJSP Supervisory Officers, establishing specifications and restrictions for the use of learned information and enabling effective oversight and audit of all such access. The Departments of Law, Finance and ITS and outside counsel have reviewed and approved the methodology and the Executive Director is recommending implementation for the Board's approval.
