The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Aviation Department

It was yet another record month for air travel at the Port Authority's airports as all three major airports and the region as a whole set new, all-time May marks. The region's total passenger traffic posted a 7.6 percent climb (+878,594 passengers) while achieving a new mark of 12.4 million passengers. As in the month of April, the domestic sector led with a 6.5 percent increase (+481,663 passengers) for a record 7.9 million passengers. The international sector, too, set a record of 4.5 million passengers, driven by a solid 9.6 percent surge (+396,931 passengers). Carriers grew their total seat capacity by 4.3 percent. Domestic seats saw a 5.3 percent rise and international seats increased by 2.7 percent. The region's total freight volume grew 2.3 percent (+4,361 tons). Domestic cargo traffic led growth with a 6.1 percent surge (+4,028 tons). International cargo inched up 0.3 percent (+334 tons).
