

New Jersey Basic Skills Training Program for Economic Growth Act End of Year Report: FY'13 P.L. 2009, Chapter 199

# **Executive Summary**

We are pleased to provide, as required in P.L. 2009, Chapter 199, the New Jersey Community College Consortium for Workforce and Economic Development's report on activities of the New Jersey Basic Skills Training Program for Economic Growth Act (NJBIA Basic Skills Workforce Training Program) for the past fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. This is the fourth year of program operation as directed by the Legislature.

This public-private partnership between the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJLWD), the New Jersey Community College Consortium for Workforce and Economic Development (Consortium) and the New Jersey Business and Industry Association (NJBIA) continues to assist the state's business community in improving workers' skills. Because of its unique flexibility, the program is able to reach more workers and employers than any other state training program.

# Program highlights:

- Over 53,000 workers served since inception.
- 79% of the businesses that participated were new in FY'13.
- 78% of businesses took advantage of our "open enrollment" style class format.
- The approval of PowerPoint and Spanish in the Workplace as new class topics in FY'13 proved very popular.
- Reduced funding of 47% in the SWF allocation compared to FY'12 caused two separate, two month suspensions of program delivery.

# **End of Year Report: FY'13**

Four years ago New Jersey Business and Industry Association (NJBIA) leaders recognized that thousands of small businesses in New Jersey were having difficulty accessing Department of Labor and Workforce Development (NJLWD) training funds due to existing grant policy restraints. Working under the leadership of NJBIA's CEO Phil Kirschner the NJBIA was instrumental in the development of the original concept for the program. Your legislation corrected and continues to remediate this problem. NJLWD Commissioner Hal Wirths is fully supportive of the program.

The program is managed by the New Jersey Community College Consortium for Workforce and Economic Development (Consortium) with instruction delivered by the state's community colleges. Instructors are seasoned college adjunct professors with experience in providing instruction to the business community. The NJBIA provides outreach to its 21,400 members, and the Consortium and community colleges supplement this with outreach to non-member employers. NJLWD manages fiscal oversight, including payment of invoices prepared by the Consortium.


Overall headcount of workers trained has now surpassed 53,000 and companies served exceed 3,600. Since the passing of the legislation the program has seen tremendous expansion of over 85% in the three major categories: workers trained, businesses served and classes delivered.

In FY'13 the project provided \$650,000 from the initial Legislative authorization in tuition training dollars for New Jersey businesses. This figure represents a 47% reduction over FY'12.

The impact of this reduced funding was felt within the first 6 months. There was a two month suspension of new classes in November and December. A \$300,000 award of discretionary funding by the Commissioner of Labor in January allowed the program to get back on track for a short time. A


\$725,000 award of funds from the Department of Labor's competitive grants category in March 2013 allowed the program to continue.

764 New Jersey employers participated in the program in FY'13 sending 11,517 of their employees to 1,070 training classes (Figures 1 & 2). The number of businesses served is down 17% and the number of employees trained is down 4% from the FY'12 program year. These decreases are attributable to the two suspension periods. See Attachment A for complete list of employers.



The training classes served employers in all 21 of New Jersey's counties. The majority of classes were delivered at employer locations and at scheduled delivery times that allowed each employer to focus on

productivity. Classes were delivered at all hours of the day and across all three standard production shifts.



A total of 1,070 training classes were delivered by 17 community colleges. The following is a listing of each college and the number of classes the college delivered.





Six of the colleges saw increases in the number of classes delivered. Hudson County Community College (2000%), Atlantic Cape Community College (166%), Essex County College (80%), Bergen Community College (48%), County College of Morris (27%), Brookdale Community College (17%) and Union County College (3%).




Computer Skills continued to be the course subject area with the strongest demand. The leader within this broad topic area is Spreadsheets. Its broad applicability to multiple business situations is at the core of this demand. This was followed by Communications Skills, which included Verbal Communication, Customer Service, Written Communication and the newly approved topic of Spanish in the Workplace. Anecdotal evidence is that companies are working harder to retain the customers they have versus growing by adding new customers. The addition of Spanish in the Workplace is a derivative of the continued importance and demand for English as a second language. As companies work to improve the language skills of their non native workers they find it equally important to train their managers and supervisors to communicate with these workers in their native language. Companies report this combination leads to improved productivity.



7,575 employees completed 738 computer skills classes. Another 275 classes, with 3,245 employees were delivered in Basic Communication Skills, including Verbal Communication, Written Communication and Basic Communication for Improved Customer Service. Employers are placing increasing importance on improved communications skills for their employees. 44 classes with 560 employees were delivered in English as a Second Language and 13 classes for 137 employees were delivered in Basic

Mathematics and Measurements. The single largest growth year to year was in English as a second language which had a 120% increase.



NJLWD designates over 90% of New Jersey's employers as "small businesses", making this generic sector a key driver of economic activity. Historically, a great many small businesses were not able to access employee training series offered by NJLWD because of minimum enrollment mandates imposed on grant recipients. The Consortium, with NJBIA's assistance, created a mechanism to serve this important economic force. The state's community colleges were empowered by NJLWD to offer "open enrollment" style classes that would aggregate employers to achieve the minimum headcount of 10. The minimal headcount was achieved through this aggregating process.

This project continues to reach these small employers in significant numbers. Of the 764 employers sending employees to training 603 or 79%, took advantage of the open enrollment style classes which were specifically targeted to small employers. 305, or 29%, of the overall number of classes offered were open enrollment style. These employers would not have been able to meet the minimum headcount requirement under normal conditions and would have been unable to access this valuable business resource without open enrollment classes. Additional evidence of the importance of this format is the fact that 26 employers were served by 2 colleges, while 3

companies were served by three different colleges. This flexibility lies at the heart of the delivery model.

Employees improved their skills as demonstrated on NJLWD's approved assessment instruments. Improvement in Basic Computer Skills was uniformly impressive with an overall improvement of 149%. Assessment scores in the Basic Communications Skills areas increased by 50%. Basic Mathematics assessment scores improved by 23.9%, while English as a Second Language participants had an improved score of 23.3%.

Low to medium wage employees are enrolled in significant numbers. Over 45% of employees who participated in training reported hourly wages of less than \$20 per hour. The 11,517 employees report an astounding 2,905 different job titles (see Attachment B for a complete list of job titles reported).

## **Program Analysis**

## Strengths

- The addition of PowerPoint and Spanish in the Workplace as approved class topics proved very popular with many businesses.
- The midyear policy change by NJLWD of no longer mandating the use of individual social security numbers has been well received. This policy change allows those workers concerned about identity theft to still participate while maintaining personal security.
- The amendment to the legislation at the beginning of the year allowed the program to align itself with various administrative changes promulgated by the Department.
- NJLWD Commissioner's waiver of no longer requiring employers with fewer than 250 employees to pay their employees' normal wage while in class has been well received by participating employers.
- Not being bound by some of the parameters of NJLWD's on-line invoicing system allows the project to be truly "demand driven".
- Class lengths are no longer driven by a pre-determined formula but are demand driven allowing employers to select the best match between class length and that employer's needs.

- Funding allows for immediate ramp up and outreach to the business community at the beginning of the fiscal year.
- Consortium's management allows faster turnaround and delivery for all businesses because those businesses do not have to go through a lengthy application process.
- Consortium's central administration allows for a single point of contact for all New Jersey businesses.
- State's community colleges provide a deep pool for instructors.
- State's community colleges provide access to 65 campus locations within 25 minutes of every resident and worker in New Jersey.
- Many of the community colleges have invested in mobile laptop computer labs allowing for technology based classes to be brought directly to company locations.
- There is a willingness to provide instruction any hour of the day or night on the company site. Customization of all classes means targeted training to better meet each business' needs.
- Cooperation between Consortium, NJLWD and NJ Office of Taxation has led to improved tax compliance on the part of participating businesses.
- Seamless collaboration between the three partners Consortium,
   NJBIA and NJLWD, allows for smooth project fiscal management and precise record keeping.

## Weaknesses

- The funding reduction at the beginning of the year placed the program, and the businesses' confidence in the program's future, in jeopardy.
- Breaks in funding had a significant negative impact on delivery. 190 scheduled classes with a tuition value of \$329,600 had to be suspended when funding was not in place in February and March. While some of these classes may have been rescheduled a significant number were lost.
- The blending of finance, i.e. legislative allocation coupled with competitive funds means two different invoicing systems that run contrary to the intent of the legislative award.

- There continues to be some difficulty organizing classes of 10 or more for very small businesses especially in the area of Basic Mathematics and English as a Second Language. Employers have trimmed their workforces to the bare bones in an attempt to remain competitive. Taking workers out of production, or office operations, is a challenge to many of these small employers. Over 58% of the scheduled classes targeting small employers had to be cancelled due to the need to hit this threshold. This is a 19% increase over FY'12.
- The additional funding that was awarded in March 2013 is being processed through the NJLWD's regular invoicing procedures and not the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) which was in place. This may severely limit the demand driven strength of the program as conceptualized.

## **Improvements**

The Consortium is especially pleased to note that weaknesses identified early in the program year continue to be addressed at the highest levels of the Department.

- Weakness Invoicing into NJLWD's CTTS on-line system is not cost effective or efficient for both the NJLWD and the Consortium. As of the date of this report the CTTS system has been decommissioned and invoicing is done manually.
  - Solution The Consortium should do all of its invoicing to NJLWD with a direct monthly invoice process. All required data will be maintained by the Consortium as per legislative mandate.
- Weakness Reductions in funding from the legislative appropriation
  put all parties under considerable pressure. Businesses are unable to
  plan and colleges cannot fulfill promises made to their business
  clients.
  - Solution- Adequate funding that meets the program's annual projections needs to be in place on July 1<sup>st</sup>. Forcing the program to return to the Department seeking funds from the competitive category under unpredictable timelines, works to contradict the intent of the legislation

Chantal Mastroianni of Enterprise Holdings knows a good deal when she hears of one. So when she learned of the grant-funded employee training offered through New Jersey's county colleges she quickly reached out to Passaic County Community College (PCCC). It pays for the materials, administration and instructors. Enterprise's contribution is that the employees take the training during their normal 8-hour workday, " said Linda. "Enterprise has made a significant contribution in employee hours and time."

Ms. Mastroianni said the investment pays dividends for the company. Employee skills are sharpened, customers notice greater efficiency and Enterprise connects to the community through PCCC.

"Our employees enjoyed it so much they told other employees and we brought PCCC back for a third and fourth time," said Mastroianni. "We promise our employees that we will continue to train and invest in them during their time with us and that impacts our bottom line. We want to tell our story and tell other employers what a great program this is and how easy and cost effective it is to work with PCCC."

Pearson Managers Take Spanish to Communicate Better with 'Pickers and Packers'

**Cranbury, NJ** — At Pearson's Cranbury Distribution Center, the company is taking a novel approach to dissolving the language barrier between its Hispanic employees and their supervisors.

It's called Spanish in the Workplace, and it's a required class for Pearson's managerial staff.

The company has enrolled its Hispanic employees in English as a Second Language for a number of years, but then Pearson turned that idea inside out by having its supervisors take Spanish. The company's thinking was simple in its brilliance. If the language barrier is approached from both ends of that barrier, then it will dissolve more quickly.

Glenn Cipriani, Pearson's vice president of distribution, said the entire Cranbury operation has become much more efficient and productive as a result of the dual-language classes. "We can communicate better and provide better customer service," he said.

The Pearson distribution center employs hundreds of people in the busy summer months to distribute 1,100 titles and over 40 million textbooks to colleges and universities around the country. Most employees are "pickers and packers" who pick and repack the textbooks in boxes along miles of computerized conveyor systems in Pearson's vast warehouse. Pearson has a large multicultural workforce and many speak little or no English. On the other side of the workforce equation, most of Pearson's management staff speaks little or no Spanish.

State Labor Commissioner Harold Wirths, who attended a final class in workplace Spanish one day last June, courageously took a quick lesson in Spanish verb forms before the entire

class before congratulating the employees on their accomplishment.
