The plates in this folder show the new, approved State Police uniform. It is distributed for the information and guidance of the public, so that they may recognize the members of the Department of State Police instantly when they see them.

By law this uniform is fully protected and it is unlawful for anyone to copy or imitate the same for any purpose. A copy of the law appears on the back of this folder.

Both the winter and the summer uniform are shown in these cuts. The summer uniform will be worn by the whole Department on or before August 1st, after which no member of the State Police will wear the former uniform of the Department on duty with the public.

## CHAPTER 216, LAWS 1929

A SUPPLEMENT to an act entitled "An act creating a Department of State Police, providing for the appointment of a superintendent thereof, together with the officers and men who shall constitute the force, defining their powers and duties, and making an appropriation for the expenses connected therewith," passed March twenty-ninth, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-one, amended April third, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-eight.

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. In addition to the regulations and powers conferred by the provisions of the act to which this act is a supplement, the Department of State Police, on or before July first, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-nine, shall have the following standard uniform to be worn only by the members of said department:

(a) Winter Uniform: French blue blouse, dark blue breeches, with yellow stripe, cap with dark blue band and French blue bell, black boots, black pistol belt, long dark blue trousers with yellow stripe for officers, French blue overcoat; all according to State Police specifications.

(b) Summer Uniform: French blue shirt, dark blue breeches, with yellow stripe, cap with dark blue band and French blue bell, black boots, black pistol belt, long dark blue trousers with yellow stripe for officers, French blue overcoat; all according to State Police specifications.

(c) The foregoing paragraphs (a) and (b) are subject to State Police regulations.

2. Every person, agent, officer or official, whether elected or appointed by any municipality, corporation, association, of whatever kind or nature, is hereby prohibited and forbidden directly or indirectly to wear, use, or order to be used or worn, copy or imitate in any respect or manner, the above standard uniform as set out in this act; and any person not a member of the Department of State Police who shall violate this provision shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punished by a fine of not exceeding two hundred and fifty dollars (\$250), or by imprisonment in the county jail for a term not exceeding one year, or both, at the discretion of the court. The term "person" as used in this act includes individuals, associations, corporations, or agents, officers or officials elected or appointed by any municipality, including counties.

3. This act shall take effect immediately.
