

REGULATION FOR ASPARAGUS CONTAINER

Adopted October 18, 1950

On and after July 1, 1951, a container for asparagus, having the designation and to be known as the Pyramid Asparagus Crate, with inside dimensions of: Length, 16-1/4 inches; width at top, 9-3/4 inches; width at bottom, 12 inches; height, 11 inches, is hereby standardized and established as legal in the State of New Jersey.
