A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expediters in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- 3. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to water-front construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) 292 - 0700, or (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, syphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. Appointments for over-the-counter processing should be arranged through the Office of Business Advocacy (below). For further information contact:

Administrative Hearings (Quasi - Judicial) - are held between the state and a particular party involving an application, enforcement - violation or an appeal.

Interest in these hearings is generally limited to those directly involved.

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

Jan. 16--THREE GREEN ACRES GRANTS TOTAL \$4 MILLION--Governor Brendan Byrne announced three major Green Acres 50 percent matching grants for Camden, Trenton and Bayonne. The Camden County Park Commission will receive \$2 million for first phase development of Waterfront Park by the Delaware River in Camden between Arch Street and Mickle Boulevard. Trenton will receive \$1 million for development of Delaware and Raritan Canal Park between Willow and Warren streets. The Camden County Park Commission and Trenton will contribute 10 percent of the total costs with 40 percent coming from the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund in both cases. Bayonne's \$1 million Green Acres grant is for development of Kill Van Kull Park II, along First Street between Humphreys and Lexington avenues. The city will provide the other 50 percent.

Jan. 18--DEP RELEASES CANCER STATISTICS--The first of a three-part series of statistical studies of cancer mortality in New Jersey and nearby counties in four other states was released by DEP. Prepared by a team headed by Dr. Michael R. Greenberg of Rutgers University, it used data from 20 years ending in 1969. Correlations were shown between cancer mortality and environmental factors such as urbanization and industrialization, as well as with ethnic backgrounds.

Jan. 19--ANNOUNCE MEETINGS ON STATEWIDE WATER MASTER PLAN--Meetings to elicit comments on progress in development of a statewide water supply master plan were announced by DEP. Meetings are Jan. 23, Ocean County Courthouse, Toms River; Jan. 25, Municipal Building, Hackettstown, and Jan. 31, Community Center, 114 Main St., Cranford. All are at 8 p.m.

Jan. 19--NEW WATER RATES FOR D & R CANAL, RESERVOIRS-DEP announced increased bulk water rates for purveyors using the Delaware and Raritan Canal and the Spruce Run-Round Valley reservoirs complex as sources. Water from the canal will go from \$50 per million gallons, to \$75, effective July 1. Water from the reservoirs will go from about \$50 to about \$73 per million gallons, effective March 31.

Jan 19.--AWARD SIX SEWERAGE FACILITY GRANTS--Governor Brendan Byrne announced awarding of six sewerage facility grants in four counties. They total \$231,460 from the Clean Waters Bond Act of 1976, which is administered by DEP. They are, Somerset, Raritan Valley Sewerage Authority, \$139,460, build additional secondary treatment facilities; Atlantic County Sewerage Authority, \$48,872 to plan wastewater treatment facilities in Mays Landing and Hamilton Township areas, and \$11,600 for plans to determine facility needs in the Mullica-Upper Great Egg Harbor region; Upper Millstone Water Management Study Group, Mercer County, \$25,912 to prepare facilities plan for Upper Millstone Watershed; Hopewell Township Municipal Utilities Authority, Mercer County, \$3,160 to prepare plans for design of facilities in Delaware River watershed area of the township, and Borough of Bay Head, Ocean County, \$2,456 for infiltration analysis of sewage collection system. State grants are for eight percent of project costs. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) provides 75 percent and the municipalities, 17 percent.

Jan. 19--DEP WINS COURT ACTION ON TOXIC WASTE FACILITY--DEP won a temporary injunction in Union County Court barring Chemical Control Corporation of Elizabeth from accepting any more chemical waste at its warehouse facility, and a court order that 12,000 stored drums of dangerous chemicals be removed immediately. DEP alleged that drums of waste were accepted faster than the facility could dispose of them, to the extent that some 30,000 drums of flammables, cyanides, acids and PCBs were on the site. DEP last May issued an order for removal of 1,200 drums per month, with all to be gone within two years.
