### **Monthly Traffic Report**

#### **Newark Liberty International John F.Kennedy International LaGuardia Stewart International Teterboro & regional satellite airport summaries**

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized."Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The COVID-19 crisis continues to affect our region's domestic and international air passenger traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 81.3 percent year-over-year in the month of October – down 9.332 million travelers. Accounting for over 75 percent of the region's total air traveler volume, the domestic sector recorded a 74.8 percent plunge – down 5.737 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 86 percent – down 3.595 million travelers. Driven by the international sector's eighth straight monthly double-digit decline (-20,862 short tons/-18 percent), the region's total air freight volume fell 5.7 percent (-10,808 short tons). Domestic cargo was far more resilient; this silver lining recorded growth of 10,054 short tons (+13.6 percent) as JFK, EWR, and SWF saw domestic cargo traffic increase by jointly handling 10,054 additional short tons compared to October 2019.
