### TRADITIONAL USE:

#### Tax Cut

A reduction in taxes paid to the government;  
Returning more money to the pockets of middle- and working-class New Jerseyans.

### CORZINE DEMOCRATS USE:

#### Tax Cut

Rhetoric used by the legislature but never acted on;  
Raising taxes 115 times in the eight years prior to Governor Christie taking office.

### Examples:

Democratic Majority Leader Sen. Loretta Weinberg: "Yes, the people of New Jersey deserve a tax cut."

*Senator Weinberg Voted To Increase Taxes \$800 Million.* (A3201, Passed Senate: 24-16, 6/28/12; Weinberg Voted Yes)

Former Senate President Dick Codey: "He wants to cut the income tax. We all want to do those kinds of things."

*Senator Codey Voted To Increase Taxes \$800 Million.* (A3201, Passed Senate: 24-16, 6/28/12; Codey Voted Yes)

Senate Budget Committee Chairman Sen. Paul Sarlo: "I am not looking to raise any taxes...There will be no new taxes in this budget."

*Senator Sarlo Voted To Increase Taxes \$800 Million.* (A3201, Passed Senate: 24-16, 6/28/12; Sarlo Voted Yes)
