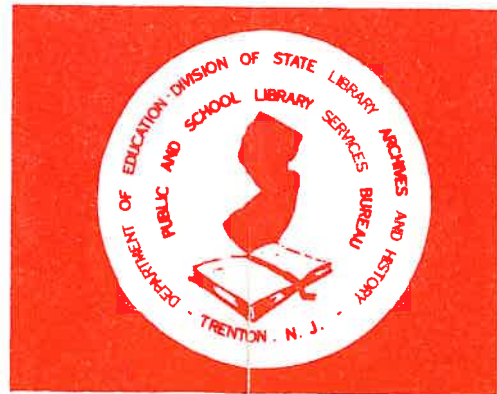

LEGAL BASIS FOR PUBLIC LIBRARY SERVICE IN NEW JERSEY

**ASSOCIATION LIBRARY:** One established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. There are 153 association libraries. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the use of the public are included in this publication.

**COUNTY LIBRARY:** One established by law following a county-wide referendum passed by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and governed by a board known as the county library commission composed of 5 members appointed by the Freeholders. There are 13 county libraries.

**FEDERATION:** Any number of independently established libraries voluntarily united to develop cooperative free public library services. Each member library retains complete institutional independence but enters into contracts or service agreements with other members to achieve the joint services agreed upon by the governing bodies of the respective libraries. There are two federation of libraries.

**JOINT LIBRARY:** One established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities. There are three joint libraries.

**MUNICIPAL LIBRARY:** One established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters vote to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a 7 member board appointed by the mayor which must include the mayor and superintendent of schools. There are 186 municipal libraries.

**REGIONAL LIBRARY:** One established by law following resolution adopted by the boards of chosen freeholders of 2 or more counties. It is governed by a board of trustees appointed by the boards of freeholders of the participating counties. There are no regional libraries to date.

NOTES ON STATISTICS

These statistics are compiled from reports submitted by individual libraries. Additional data and processing was supplied as indicated below.

<u>Column</u>	<u>Explanation</u>
Library Name	Generally the municipality name identifies a public library. Where a library name differs from that of the municipality, the library name is inserted in parentheses under the name of the municipality.  Where more than one municipality support a library the combined figures for both municipalities are shown for the following items: population, equalized valuation, local tax support and per capita state aid.
Type	The following letters are used to indicate type of library: A - Association; J - Joint Library; and M - Municipal Library. County Libraries are identified by name and not indicated in this column.
Estimated Population Served	Source: <u>New Jersey Population Estimates - 1967</u> by New Jersey Department of Conservation and Economic Development. Population for county libraries exclude exempt municipalities.
Equalized Valuation	Source: <u>Table of Equalized Valuation</u> by New Jersey Department of the Treasury, Division of Taxation - 1967 Conformed copy.
Local Tax Support	Excludes county taxes. Source: Municipal budgets submitted to Division of Local Government, Department of Community Affairs.
Per Capita State Aid	Amounts shown represent State Aid sent to municipalities in December 1967. "Total State Aid" includes the sum of amounts sent to municipalities providing tax support for library service.
Per Capita Expenditures	Represents total expenditure divided by the estimated population served. Excluded from county and state totals are: (1) population of libraries not reporting total expenditure, and (2) county library taxes.
Per Capita Expenditure Including County Tax	Represents Total Expenditure Plus County Tax for County Member Libraries. County and state totals exclude populations from municipalities not reporting total expenditure.
