Purpose for Which Funds will be Used:

The FY25 Bridges to Employing Youth continuation grant will provide specialized workforce development services to youth with disabilities, justice-involved youth, youth who are or have aged out of foster care or are displaced, and pregnant or parenting youth, in an effort to enhance the current practices and systems intended to serve their needs. NJDOL expects that this program will focus on partnerships and collaboration between state and local agencies and systems to create a coordinated process in ensuring the healthy career development of these populations.
