Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

Following two consecutive monthly declines, the region's total air passenger volume inched into positive territory (+0.2 percent/+21,156 passengers). The international sector led growth with 30,879 added travelers (+0.6 percent), as carriers increased international seats by 0.3 percent. Domestic passenger activity posted its third continuous drop (-0.1 percent/-9,723 passengers). The region's total cargo volume posted its sharpest decrease of 2019 (-8.8 percent/-17,102 tons). July was revised due to overstated tonnage by Emirates, which the airline later corrected. International cargo (over 60 percent of our region's total freight) posted its 10th consecutive decline (-12.3 percent/-14,937 tons). Domestic cargo recorded its first dip of 2019 (-3 percent/-2,165 tons).
