All three major Port Authority airports set new July passenger records, leading to a new July regional passenger volume mark of 13.135 million travelers—a 4 percent gain (+504,674 travelers). The domestic sector led growth, handling a record 8.062 million passengers—a 4.6 percent increase (+358,158 passengers). Domestic seat capacity increased by 4.5 percent. The international sector also achieved a new record of 5.073 million passengers—a 3 percent rise (+146,516 passengers). International seats improved by 1.7 percent. Total freight volume grew 2 percent (+3,636 tons). Following a 0.3 percent uptick in June, domestic freight activity set the pace with a 12.7 percent jump (+7,396 tons). International cargo, which accounts for over 60 percent of the region's total, landed in negative territory (-3 percent/-3,758 tons).
