xvii. 30 miles per hour to the intersection of Broad Street, City of Elizabeth, Union County; thence

xviii. 35 miles per hour to the City of Elizabeth—City of Newark corporate line, Union County; except

xix. A 25 miles per hour speed limit for the Roosevelt grammar school zone, during recess or while children are going to or leaving school, during opening or closing hours, in the City of Rahway, Union County.
