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Report of the Board of Shell Fisheries

To the Honorable Walter E. Edge, Governor:

We are pleased to be able to continue to make a favorable report of the shell fish industry of our State, and to inform you that while there appears to be a great scarcity of seed oysters in the country, which will mean a scarcity of the matured crop for the next year or two at least, that New Jersey has one of the finest crops of seed oysters ever produced in the State, and should be able to continue the supply of the matured product and we believe can and will very materially increase that supply.

The great oyster producing grounds of Maurice River Cove and Delaware Bay has produced one of, if not the greatest crop of seed oysters ever produced on those wonderfully productive beds and while these were quite small they were planted to the extent of several million bushels and are doing nicely, thereby assuring a fine crop of marketable oysters for 1919 and 1920.

The mature crop surpasses that of last year, which was agreed by the oldest planters was the finest ever taken from the Maurice River Cove. These are being placed upon the market at a very slight advance in price notwithstanding the fact of the very great cost of labor and everything else into the cost of production. We find, however, that a great many of the retail dealers are taking advantage of the unsettled conditions and have increased the price of oysters out of all proportion to the price paid and we believe this has had a tendency to curtail the using of oysters to a very great extent.

Believing that oysters should in a very great measure take the place of meat as a food product and thereby conserve our meat supply, we called the attention of Mr. Hoover to the price boosting or profiteering, and have received promise of help from him to try and adjust or keep down prices of oysters through the licensing of the wholesaler and thus pre-

venting the wholesaler from selling to the retailer who charges exorbitant prices.

Through the passage of the law at the last session of the Legislature giving to the Board greater powers of controlling the industry on the Atlantic Coast, we believe that we are going to increase the industry of that section to a very great extent and especially do we feel this can be done in Barnegat Bay where several thousand acres of what is believed to be very valuable producing ground has been practically laying idle because of the sentiment of a few people who claimed the right to go there and gather a few bushels of natural oysters from these grounds when there happened to be a natural growth on the said grounds. About or near two thousand acres of this ground has been leased and the lessees planted several thousand bushels of shells on the same, and got a fairly good catch of spat. Because of railroad and labor conditions, however, they could only get a very small percentage of the shells spread which they had expected to put down but have made arrangements with the railroad company, who have put in a siding for them, and the lessees are expecting to put up wharves and platforms for storing shells for future planting and we are expecting to lease much more land another season and see the spreading of shells on a much more extensive scale.

We are anxious to see the completion of the canal from the head of Barnegat Bay to the Manasquan River, believing that it will add several thousand acres of very fine oyster producing grounds to the already extensive oyster grounds of Barnegat Bay and that it will greatly improve the grounds where oysters now grow by giving the fresh water of the upper bay and streams a short outlet to the sea, thereby creating a much greater degree of salinity in that part of the bay which seems best suited for oyster culture because of the character of the bottom. We know that by increasing the salinity of the water, we will get a much more rapid growth of oysters and are also hopeful that it will greatly increase our clam producing bottom.

We desire also to call your attention to the fact that under the above-mentioned act we have leased several large plots of ground in Newark Bay and Staten Island Sound for the propa-

gation of seed oysters, after what we considered a pretty thorough investigation as to the advisability of leasing these grounds. The lessees started to clean up the grounds and spread shell over them and because of this activity on the part of the lessees, a report or rather complaint, was made to the Director that the lessees were removing thousands of bushels of the finest seed oysters from the grounds. The Director went to the grounds in question, and ordered the Captains of the boats to stop work until he could call a meeting of the Board and arrange for a more thorough investigation of the matter. The meeting was called and arrangements made for a trip of inspection on one of the boats of the J. & J. W. Elsworth Company which boat was equipped with dredges and all the necessary apparatus for doing the work necessary for a very thorough inspection of the grounds in question, and with seven of the members of the Board, the Director and Chiefs and several of the oyster planters of that section who had known and worked these grounds before their productiveness was destroyed by Government dredging, the dumping of stone ballast, cinder and ashes from the thousands of steamers which are navigated through those waters, and other kinds of waste material too numerous to mention, we found that the lessees were dredging this bottom, not for oysters as had been reported, but for the purpose of clearing off the mud which had settled over what was once very productive oyster beds and their purpose was to thoroughly clean these old beds and then spread clean shells over them hoping in this way to bring back to a state of productiveness. This work will cost the lessees several thousand dollars and as most of those present expressed it "it required some nerve to undertake a proposition of that kind." Now just a word of explanation as to why these lessees are making this expensive experiment—not long since the oyster business of Raritan Bay was in a flourishing condition but because of the flow of trade waste into the streams, sound, and bays of that locality, and the other causes enumerated above, the natural supply of seed oysters have become depleted and while it is a question which up to this time has not been solved, yet it is a fact that there are some localities in which none but native seed oysters will thrive, and

Raritan Bay seems to be one of these waters, and as there are extensive planting grounds in the bay and no supply of seed oysters available that can be planted profitably upon those grounds, it is only natural that the planters residing in that neighborhood should make a very great effort to secure this seed supply. This is the reason for the experiment in Newark Bay and Staten Island Sound.

In conclusion, we desire to add that while a portion of our report appears to be glowing, that the oyster business is very hazardous, and while in some part of the State the planters have been very successful the last few years, in other parts it has been just the reverse and we have known of and heard men say who planted extensively, "Well, I expected to be on Easy Street after marketing my crop this year, but now I have got to commence all over again." Cases of loss of this kind mostly are caused by heavy storms which covers the oysters with either sand or mud, and that very often occurs, but there are so many enemies of the oyster that destroy them 365 days in the year—such as drum fish, star fish, oyster fish, crabs, drills, winkles and conks,—then, when they are grown large enough for market they are very often poor, in which case they are not marketable, and then begins a very heavy death rate and very often the whole crop is lost, as when the death rate is very heavy it does not pay to work the ground, and it is abandoned. Some of the conditions cited above are responsible for many of the failures of those who have invested money in the business with no practical knowledge of the requirements as it does not follow that money to buy seed oysters and seed oysters thrown overboard means a crop of marketable oysters any more than it does to furnish money to buy seed to put into the wrong kind of ground. It requires the same expert knowledge of grounds, seed oysters, proper planting, etc., to make a successful oyster farmer that it does to make a successful land farmer.
