The region's total passenger volume grew by 3.7 percent (+393,757 travelers) and set a new mark of 11.026 million travelers for the month of March. The international sector led growth with an 8.4 percent surge (+292,958 passengers) while setting a new record of 3.778 million passengers. Carriers increased their international seats by 3.5 percent. Meanwhile, domestic traffic, too, established a new mark of 7.248 million travelers, despite a comparatively modest 1.4 percent improvement (+100,799 passengers). With domestic seats up 2.8 percent, carriers saw lower load factors. The region's cargo momentum continued in March as total freight traffic posted a 7.2 percent increase (+13,462 tons). International cargo, which accounts for 64 percent of the region's total cargo traffic, was the main growth driver with a 9.5 percent climb (+11,493 tons). Domestic cargo volume posted a 3 percent gain (+1,969 tons).
