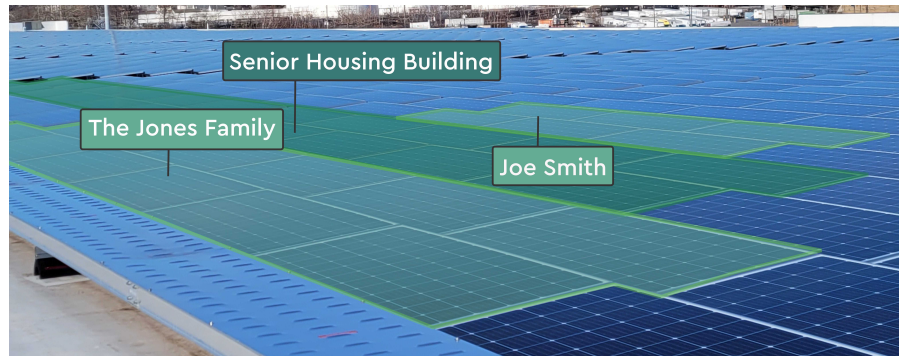

Community Solar FAQ and Glossary

What is Community Solar?

Community solar is for anyone who wants to benefit from solar energy generation without installing panels directly on their roofs. This is an ideal opportunity for renters, homeowners with shaded roofs, or anyone else that is unable to install their own solar array on their property to participate and benefit from the generation of renewable energy.

A community solar project is a solar array whose energy generation is financially divided among multiple participating subscribers. As a subscriber, you will receive a financial credit on your utility bill for the portion of power generated by the array on your behalf. Separately, you will be responsible for paying a subscription fee to the community solar project. Community solar projects are designed so that your utility bill credit is larger than the subscription fee, meaning that you save money!

About the Municipal Automatic Enrollment Program (also known as the Opt-Out Program)

Starting in 2025, New Jersey's Community Solar Program allows municipal governments to create a Municipal Automatic Enrollment Project to bring the benefits of community solar to low- and moderate-income residents in their community.

What should I do if I have received a notification that my household will be enrolled in a Community Solar Project through the automatic enrollment process?

You do not need to do anything to start enjoying the benefits of the community solar project. Once the project your municipality has selected is electrified, your monthly electric bill will show a community solar credit, see the [FAQ page](#) to learn more about this credit. If a resident does not want to participate in the Community Solar program for any reason, instructions for opting out of the program will be included with the notification received. Participants can opt-out of the program at anytime without having to pay a fee or penalty.
