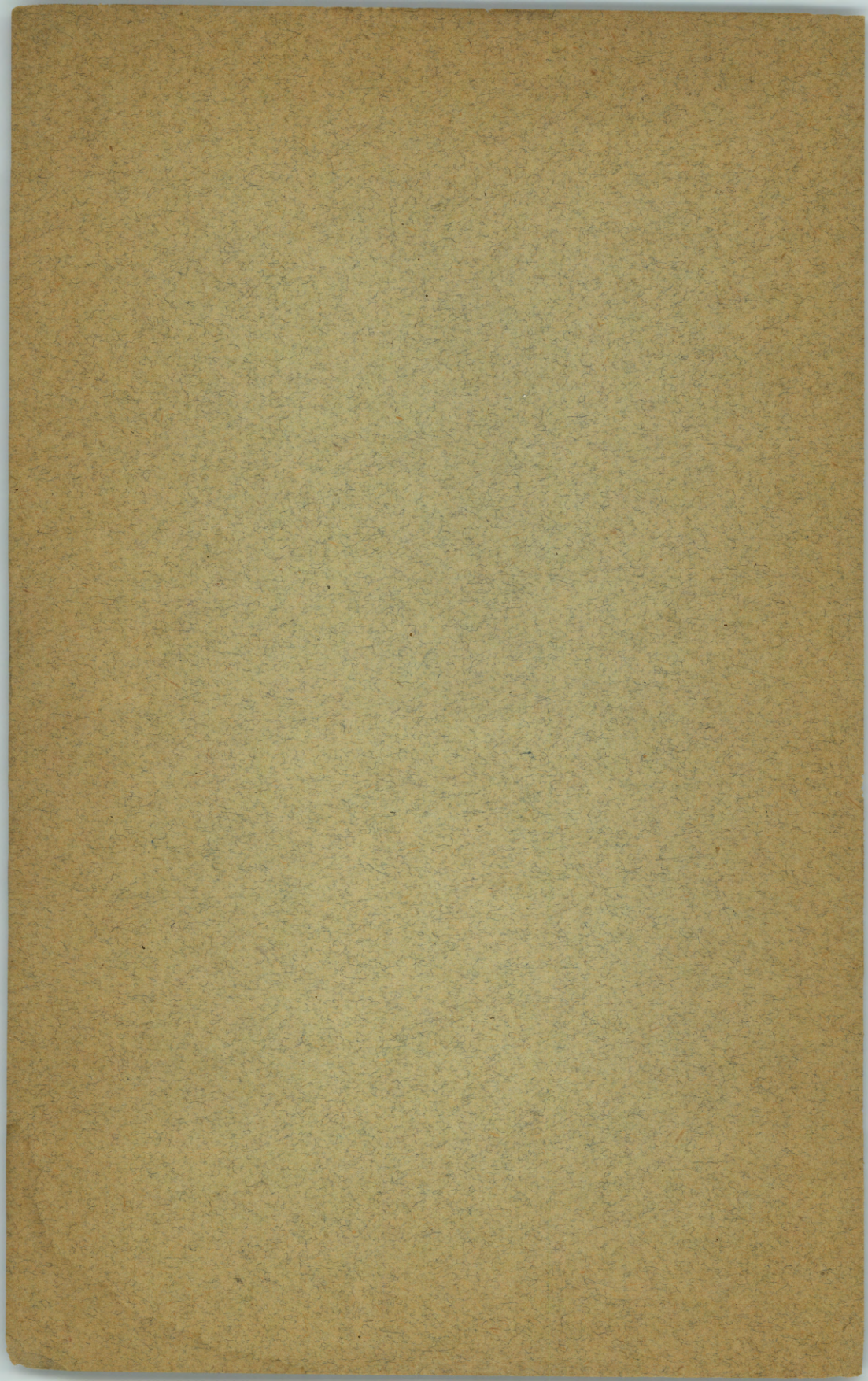

REPORT.

Hon. Foster M. Voorhees, Governor of New Jersey:

DEAR SIR—The New Jersey Public Library Commission respectfully submits the following report of its doings for transmission to the Legislature:

With the appropriation of \$200 for traveling and incidental expenses carried in the supplemental appropriation bill passed by the last Legislature, the Commission has been able to begin the work for which it was created, and during the summer has advised with many persons interested in organizing or maintaining public libraries in some of the smaller municipalities. The appropriation of \$1,000 to be used in aiding free public libraries under municipal control did not become available until November 1st, and therefore none of the municipalities has yet received financial aid. In several cases trained librarians have been sent to assist those engaged in the preliminary work of establishing libraries, and counsel and advice have been freely given by correspondence.

During the current year the Commission was enabled, through the personal interest of one of its members, to publish a Hand-Book of New Jersey Libraries, containing a compilation of the Public Library laws of the State; an illustrated report on the condition of the libraries, with statistics of the same, and other information useful to those interested in establishing free public libraries. The work was begun in April, but by reason of the lack of knowledge of the existence of some of the libraries, and the failure of librarians and others to respond promptly, the book was not ready until the close of the fiscal year. It is now being distributed.

At a meeting of the Commission on April 15th Dr. E. C. Richardson and Mr. F. P. Hill were appointed a committee to prepare a list of the titles of one thousand volumes which the Commission would recommend for purchase for a public library. The object was to present a list of such books as might safely be bought by those in-

terested in small libraries, and who might not have at hand the various catalogues required, or might lack the experience and time needed in making the selections. Such a list, once prepared, it was believed, would save much work for others. It was the intention to make the list of titles a part of the Commission's Hand-Book; but soon after his appointment on the committee Mr. Hill removed from the State, and later resigned from the Commission, and the work fell to Dr. Richardson.

The list has been completed, and is submitted as an appendix to this report.

The statistical table prepared for the Commission's Hand-Book is also submitted as a part of this report, since it shows, for the first time, the extent of New Jersey's library interests. With the exception of about half a dozen seminary and preparatory school libraries which declined to answer requests for information, the table contains all of the libraries of the State of the existence of which knowledge could be obtained by persistent inquiry. Besides the 102 libraries named, the Commission has been informed at the offices of the Superintendent of Public Instruction that there are 1,495 free school libraries in the State, purchased under the provision of the School law which grants financial aid for the purpose in cases where the schools have raised a certain amount of money. There are also about twenty-five teachers' libraries created under a similar provision.

In preparing the Library laws for publication it became apparent that there were many conflicting and superfluous provisions. No attempt was made to simplify or reconcile these, the purpose being to present, in their entirety, the laws on the subject. It is conceded generally that the acts governing the organization of free public libraries in New Jersey are the best that have been passed in any of the States, and when the work of revising the statutes is completed many of the obsolete and amended sections will be eliminated and a simplification result that cannot fail to be of great advantage to those interested in public libraries.

During the past year the new public libraries at Jersey City, Newark and Hackensack have been finished and occupied; a large addition has been made to that at Paterson; in Trenton a new public library is being erected at a cost of over \$100,000 for the building and site, and it will be ready for use early in the new year with nearly 20,000 volumes; Vineland has voted to accept the provisions of the law and

has organized a library of more than 2,000 volumes, which are kept in a room set apart for library purposes in the city hall. At the election recently held in Atlantic City there was an almost unanimous vote in favor of establishing a free public library in that great summer resort, and the Commission has just learned that Mr. Peter Reid, of Passaic, has given upwards of \$50,000 for a public library in the Dundee or factory district of that city. Passaic already has a free public library of about 10,000 volumes, which has been doing splendid work. Freehold, Branchville and Fair Haven have recently organized libraries, and Phillipsburg is considering the establishment of one. East Rutherford opened a new library on September 24th, the necessary funds having been raised by a fair held for the library's benefit last winter. A free public library will be opened in Belleville within a few weeks.

From the statistical table given it will be seen that there are many subscription libraries in existence. Whenever occasion has offered, the Public Library Commission has advised that an effort be made to have the provisions of the General Library laws accepted by popular vote, and that these subscription libraries be turned over to municipal control. In that event the library would receive a regular annual income, derived from the one-third of a mill tax on each dollar of ratables, and its affairs would be conducted by a board of trustees, in which the municipality would have representation. The main objection raised to this course by some of those interested in subscription libraries has been the fear that the libraries would come under political control, and that the present owners or stockholders would be excluded from a voice in the management.

The fear of political interference, it is needless to say, is groundless. In Jersey City, Newark, Paterson, Passaic, New Brunswick, Trenton, Hoboken and other cities there has been no such experience. And though there would undoubtedly be a change in management, the appointing power, it has been found, is very willing to designate as trustees those who are interested and experienced in library management. According to reports made to the Commission some of these subscription libraries are but little used, are rarely opened to the public, and are unprovided with the means of maintaining the institutions. The Commissioners feel that they will be doing quite as efficient work in revivifying some of these established libraries as in establishing new ones.

Princeton University Library, established in 1746, is the oldest in

the State, as it is also by far the largest. Burlington came twelve years later, in 1758, with a charter from King George II., and is the oldest public library. Then follow the Rutgers College Library, established in 1766, and the library of the Theological Seminary of the Reformed Church in America, in 1784. The total number of books and pamphlets in all of the public and semi-public libraries in the State will probably reach 1,200,000. Sunday-school libraries are not included in this estimate. Fifty-two of the 102 libraries reporting are free, and thirty-eight subscription; and of the eighty-eight cities and towns in which libraries are located, seventy-six have libraries in the public schools also.

Of the \$200 appropriated for the incidental expenses of the Commission up to October 31st, 1901, \$20 was spent for postage, \$12.50 for stationery, \$146.20 for printing, and \$12.30 for traveling expenses. The Commissioners respectfully request that the appropriation for these expenses be increased, in order that clerical assistance may be employed, and that the calls from the smaller towns for the services of expert librarians may be responded to.

APPENDIX.

FIRST ONE THOUSAND BOOKS FOR A NEW JERSEY LIBRARY.

The purpose of this list of titles of the first one thousand books which the Public Library Commission recommends for purchase for a New Jersey public library has been stated in the preceding report. Before the list was ready for publication, Dr. E. C. Richardson, the compiler, was called to Europe, and its final preparation was, in accordance with Dr. Richardson's request, intrusted to a committee of the New Jersey Library Association. This committee naturally felt a little delicacy about making any changes in Dr. Richardson's work during his absence, merely making the suggestion (which the Commission endorsed) that where possible libraries should also procure copies of State, county and local histories, and should apply to the Commissioners of the State Library for copies of such volumes of the New Jersey Archives as can be furnished. Also, that the monographs published by the New Jersey Historical Society would be valuable, and the desirability of preserving a file of a local newspaper is apparent.

It will be noted that titles of works on philosophy and religion have been omitted, and the selection of books on these subjects is left to the local library authorities.

Purchasing committees will be able to effect a considerable saving in discounts if they will prepare a list of the books wanted and submit it to their local booksellers and to large dealers in some of the larger cities.

The Library of Congress is now furnishing printed catalogue cards for books copyrighted in the United States since July 1st, 1898, and for many other books in its present collection. The purchase of these is advised, as they will be furnished at a rate lower than it would cost to have them written; and besides the advantage of having printed cards, they will serve as models for inexperienced librarians and cataloguers.
