COVID-19 Vaccines

Everyone 6 months or older is eligible for a COVID-19 vaccine in New Jersey and encouraged to get vaccinated as soon as possible.

Everyone 6 months and older is eligible for an **updated bivalent booster that targets the Omicron variant**, if it has been at least two months since your most recent booster or primary series.

COVID-19 vaccines are safe and highly effective at preventing you from getting sick.
