Governor Whitman today filed the following conditional vetoes. Conditional veto messages are attached.

A-2055, sponsored by Assembly Members Charles "Ken" Zisa (D- Bergen) and Loretta Weinberg (D-Bergen) and Senators Robert Singer (R- Burlington/Monmouth/Ocean) and C. Louis Bassano (R- Essex/Union), would establish the Prostate Cancer Awareness, Education, Research Program in the Department of Health and Senior Services with an appropriation of \$1 million.

A-1884, sponsored by Assembly Members Carol Murphy (R- Essex/Morris/Passaic) and Nicholas Asselta (R-Atlantic/Cape May/Cumberland) and Senator James Cafiero (R-Cape May/ Atlantic/ Cumberland), would allow private operators to establish adult day care programs for victims of Alzheimer's disease, provide for sliding fee scale for services and appropriate \$803,000.

ACS for A-2317, sponsored by Assembly Members Alan Augustine (R- Middlesex/ Morris/ Somerset/Union) and Barbara Wright (R- Mercer/Middlesex) and Senators Joseph Vitale (D-Middlesex) and John Bennett (R-Monmouth), would require health care facilities to use certain safety needles and sharp devices.

A-30, sponsored by Assembly Members Joseph R. Malone III (R- Burlington/Monmouth/Ocean) and Rose Marie Heck (R-Bergen) and Senator William Kavanaugh (R-Morris/Somerset), would revise and strengthen various laws concerning public contracting.
