ADMISSIONS, RELEASES AND RESIDENTS
MARCH 1993

Compared to the trimester ending March 31, 1992 Admissions for trimester ending March 31, 1993 were:

- Down 2% from 2916 to 2855 for the Prison;
- Down 1% from 237 to 235 for the Edna Mahan Correctional Facility;
- Down 26% from 145 to 108 for the Youth Complex; and
- Up 6% from 270 to 287 for Juvenile Facilities.

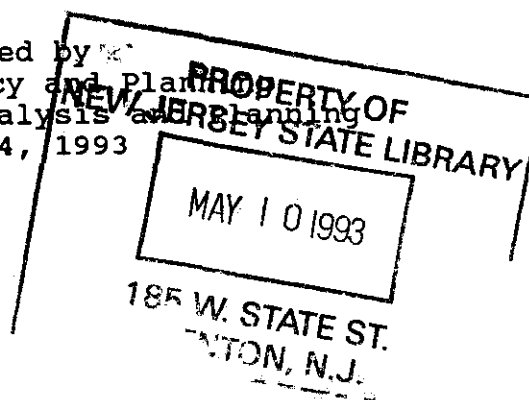
Resident counts on March 31, 1993 compared to the end of March 31, 1992 were:

- Down 5% from 23,332 to 22,135 for the Adult Jurisdictional population (County Waiting, County Contract, County Assistance, Prison Complex, Youth Complex);
- Down 20% from 3351 to 2689 for County Waiting;
- Down 5% from 23,956 to 22,710 for all Institutions;
- Down 3% from 14,445 to 13,956 for the Prison;
- Down 4% from 4803 to 4615 for the Youth Facilities, and
- Down 8% from 612 to 565 for Juvenile Facilities.

NOTES: DEFINITION OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ **ADMISSIONS** include commitments, parole returns for technical violation, and Prison and Correctional returns from escape actually received at State Institutions.
- b/ **PAROLE RELEASES** are counted in terms of institution of release, not type of sentence released from (e.g. Prison min/max offenders released from Youth Correctional Units are counted as Youth Correctional releases).
- c/ **RESIDENTS** include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on last day of reporting period. For the Prison Complex and Youth Complex, number on furlough is included only in the total complex counts and not in the counts for separate units. Also note that past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Also note that, for this report, resident counts are based on physical location and not correctional jurisdiction (e.g. Prison offenders housed in correctional facilities are included in correctional counts).
- d/ **MEDIUM/MAX UNITS:** Footnote "d" identifies units providing medium or maximum custody. The count provided includes all inmates resident in units which primarily house inmates requiring more than minimum custody. Thus these counts are not a count of inmate custody status but are a count of the total number of inmates resident in designated units.
