Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The weather took a terrible toll on our passenger traffic as first quarter traffic fell 0.7%. Overall traffic was down for each of the first three months. The last time the region experienced three months of successive declines was in the midst of the last recession (April-June 2009). For the period, nearly 20,700 flights were cancelled at our three major airports, compared to 9,300 for the same period last year. Falling 2.1%, domestic traffic experienced most of the cancellations. In contrast, YTD international traffic grew 2.2%. The region's first quarter freight declined 3.3%. Though March's freight was down only 0.1%, it nevertheless represents 31 consecutive down months since June 2011 (excluding August 2012 and January 2013). Additionally, freighter (cargo-only) flights are down 9.2%.
