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The Bureau of Information Resources Management, Division of Administration, and New Jersey State Department of Education originally developed the computer programs used in this compilation. With the transfer of the State Library in 1996 from the Department of Education to an affiliation with Thomas Edison State College, the programs have been migrated to SAS for Windows.

New Jersey State Library staff work closely with IMLS to ensure accurate and timely data are made available to library administrations in New Jersey and library researchers nationally.

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INTRODUCTION

The mission of the New Jersey State Library is to lead in the provision, promotion and support of excellent library and information services to state government and to all the people of New Jersey.

The New Jersey State Library annually compiles statewide library statistics to help libraries analyze and improve programs and services. Trustees and library directors use the statistics to develop and justify budgets and for comparative evaluation of programs, staffing practices and collection development.

Primarily three types of libraries provide public library services in New Jersey:

1) **Municipal** – a library established by law following a referendum in which the majority of voters decided to establish such a library. It is supported by taxes and is governed by a board, appointed by the mayor, which must include the mayor and the superintendent of schools or their alternates. There are 233 municipal libraries in New Jersey, although not all report for inclusion in these statistics. They are identified in the tables by an **M**.

2) **County** – a library established by law following a countywide referendum approved by a majority of voters. It is supported by taxes and generally governed by a board known as the county library commission, composed of five to seven members appointed by the freeholders. There are 14 county libraries identified in the tables by a **C**.

3) **Association** – a library established, governed and supported by an association of citizens. Such an association is incorporated, forms its own constitution, appoints or elects its own board and is responsible for operation of the library. It may receive tax support from the local governing body. Only those association libraries whose services are free to the public are included in this publication. Some libraries formerly listed as association libraries are now branches or stations of their county libraries. There are 46 association libraries in New Jersey, although not all report for inclusion in these statistics. They are identified in the tables by an **A**.

In addition, there are six **joint** libraries in New Jersey, which are identified in the tables by a **J**. A joint library is established by law following a referendum in two or more municipalities, which was approved by the majority of voters. It is governed by a board appointed by the mayors of the participating municipalities.

Note: Summary tables show the number and percentage of population served by public libraries (Tables 1 and 2), libraries according to size of population served (Table 3), libraries according to total expenditures (Table 4), and libraries according to type and total expenditures (Table 5). Tables showing individual library statistics by county and a state summary constitute the body of this publication. These Survey Year data use the 2010 New Jersey population figures for population served. Equalized Valuation data is from the Survey Year. (Note: Per Capita State Aid is based on the equalized valuation for the year prior to the Survey Year.) Where a public library is supported by more than one municipality, the figures combine the municipalities. Explanations of the column headings follow. Where data have been taken from annual public library statistical reports for the Survey Year, the line number of the report used is given in parentheses at the end of the explanation of each column heading below.

DEFINITIONS

NOTE: DEFINITIONS ARE FOR ANNUAL STATISTICS UNLESS INDICATED OTHERWISE

CHILDREN'S CIRCULATION AS A PERCENTAGE OF TOTAL CIRCULATION

Using the library's local definition of adult and children's materials, this calculation shows the percentage of circulated materials that were classified as children's. This includes interlibrary loan and reciprocal loans. (Lines 5.2 + 5.4 + 5.6 + 5.10 divided by Line 5.11)

EQUALIZED VALUATION

The Division of Taxation, New Jersey Department of Treasury, supplied the equalized valuation of municipalities. Amounts are shown to the nearest thousand dollars and exclude municipalities that do not officially support library services. For county libraries, the equalized valuation reported is the total of all municipalities that provide tax support.

EXPENDITURES: LIBRARY MATERIALS

Included are the amounts expended for books, periodicals, newspapers, microforms, all other non-print materials and binding. (Line 2.16)

EXPENDITURES: SALARIES, WAGES AND BENEFITS

Amounts reported here include salaries, wages and fringe benefits paid to all library employees, whether paid from the library budget or from the municipal or county budget. Retirement benefits paid are excluded. (Line 2.5)

EXPENDITURES: TOTAL

Total expenditures as reported by libraries, represent current operations and exclude amounts spent for capital improvements, repayment of loans, etc. The difference of total expenditures, less those for salaries, wages, benefits, and for library materials, represents all other operating expenditures. (Line 2.24) NOTE: Total expenditures may exceed total income, since the balance carried forward from the prior year (Line 1.3) has been deducted to yield current-year income.

HOURS OPEN WEEKLY

The number of hours per week the main library was open for public service during the major part of the year. (Line 6.1)

INCOME: LOCAL TAX

Local tax support is shown as reported by individual libraries as the sum of appropriated and additional tax support. (Line 1.6)

NOTE: Calculation of State Library Per Capita Aid is based on amounts expended from municipal or county budgets for library purposes.

INCOME: PER CAPITA STATE AID

Amounts shown as per capita state aid were reported as paid in Data Year to municipalities and counties with libraries. State Aid to network contract libraries and emergency aid/incentive grants are not shown in this column. (Line 1.8)

INCOME: TOTAL

Amounts shown are library operation income from all sources (Line 1.15), but excluding the balance brought forward from the prior year (Line 1.3). State aid to network contract libraries and emergency aid/incentive grants are included. (Line 1.15 less Line 1.3)

LIBRARY ATTENDANCE

The total number of persons who entered the library including those persons attending activities or meetings that were held at the library. (Line 7.1)

NON-PRINT MATERIAL CIRCULATION

Any loan of non-print material. (Line 5.12)

NUMBER OF ADULT PROGRAMS PRESENTED

Using the library's local definition of adult, this is the total of all library-sponsored programs offered to adults. If the program was for all ages, it is reported in this category. (Line 7.1)

NUMBER OF CHILDREN'S PROGRAMS PRESENTED

Using the library's local definition of children, this is the total of all library-sponsored programs offered to children. (Line 7.6)

NUMBER OF REFERENCE TRANSACTIONS

The number of transactions conducted during the designated twelve-month period between a library staff member and a member of the public for which a written source is or can be cited. A transaction is defined as a group of processing steps that are treated as a single activity to perform the desired result of answering the inquiry. Questions that may be answered by fetching, pointing or giving directions or that require no special knowledge by experienced staff such as searching for a book by title or a phone number by person's name are not considered reference transactions. (Line 7.2)

NUMBER PARTICIPATING IN SUMMER READING PROGRAM

The number of children who enrolled in the summer reading program. (Line 7.9)

PER CAPITA: EXPENDITURES INCLUDING COUNTY TAX

For county libraries and county-library members, these amounts are derived from the sum of total local expenditures and county-library tax support paid, divided by population served. (While amounts paid by municipalities in support of a county library are not printed in these tables, they are included in these computations and were taken from county abstracts of ratable property.)

PER CAPITA : LOCAL EXPENDITURES

Dividing total expenditures by population served derives these amounts. This column excludes amounts paid by municipalities in support of county libraries.

POPULATION SERVED

The total population of New Jersey as of April 1, 2010 was 8,791,894 as released in the **Decennial Census**, issued by the U. S. Department of Labor, Bureau of the Census. 8,708,144 of this population are served by a public library; defined as having access to a public library within the municipal boundary, through a joint library agreement or to service provided by a county library. The remaining population may be unserved or have access to a municipal or county library through a contractual agreement. These municipalities and their current status are listed on page 43.

The population served by a county library is the total of all municipalities that provide tax support, including the populations of the member-libraries listed below the county-library entry.

PUBLIC ACCESS INTERNET TERMINALS

The number of computers designated for public use to access the Internet. (Line 9.12)

STAFF: FULL TIME

The number of individuals working full-time for a minimum of 35 hours per week as of December of the year for which the statistics are gathered. (Line 3.2)

STAFF: FULL TIME EQUIVALENTS (FTE)

The annual total of paid staff hours divided by 1,820. (Line 3.11)

STAFF: PROFESSIONAL CERTIFIED

The number of library staff members who hold New Jersey Professional Librarian certification. (Line 3.7)

SUBSCRIBED PERIODICALS

The number of current paid subscription titles, including newspapers and magazines other than annuals. (Line 4.27)

TOTAL BOOKS READ FOR THE SUMMER READING PROGRAM

The number of books that were read by the participants. Statistics kept in minutes are converted by dividing the total number of minutes by 60. (Line 7.10)

TOTAL CIRCULATION

The total circulation of library materials, adult and juvenile, including reciprocal borrowing, loans of library materials in bulk to other institutions and interlibrary loans. (Line 5.11)

TOTAL PROGRAM ATTENDANCE

The total attendance for the adult and children's library-sponsored programs offered.

VOLUMES OWNED YEAR END

The number of books reported (including books in microform). Other materials, which are prepared, cataloged and recorded in the same manner as books are also reported here. (Line 4.22)

VOLUMES: PER CAPITA

Dividing the number of volumes owned at the end of the year by the population served derives these amounts.

VOLUMES: PURCHASED DURING YEAR

The number of volumes purchased (including books in microform if cataloged) by public libraries is exclusive of volumes supplied by county libraries and gifts. (Line 4.12)

USER COUNT FOR ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

The estimated number of people, including repeat customers, using the library's public access computers to access the Internet. (Line 9.4)

AVERAGES

Averages have been calculated for county-member subtotals, county summaries, and state totals for the following columns: Per Capita Local Expenditures, Per Capita Expenditures Including County Tax, Volumes Per Capita, and Hours Open Weekly.

NON-REPORTING LIBRARIES

Libraries that failed to file an annual report for the Survey Year still appear in the tables with their library type, population served and equalized valuation as the data are available from other sources.

AVERAGE PRICE PAID FOR BOOKS IN 2012 BY NEW JERSEY PUBLIC LIBRARIES

Average Price Paid Per Volume in 2012: \$15.05

Many libraries use the average price per volume to assist in setting their budgets for library materials and to meet the State Library Aid Administrative-Code criteria for number of volumes purchased. As detailed in the New Jersey Administrative Code, 15:21-2.5 (b), the funds spent for audiovisual materials, electronic reference services, and computer software when divided by the average price paid per volume in the most-recent year published, gives an equivalent number of volumes which may be added to the number of print volumes purchased. Alternately, the total materials expenditure (excluding periodicals) may be divided by the average price per volume to yield the total number of volumes purchased.

From the 2012 annual statistical reports, Lines 2.6 plus 2.7, "Expenditures for Books," totaled **\$25,417,329 for the 271 public** libraries reporting. The net total of Line 4.12, "Book Stock Number of Volumes Purchased." was 1,688,462. Thus, the average price per volume purchased in 2012 was \$15.28.

The \$15.28 average price for 2012 will be used with 2013 data for calculation of the FY 2014 State Library Aid requirement for the number of volumes purchased during 2013.
