PRELIMINARY RELEASE

NEW JERSEY RELIEF CENSUS, NOVEMBER 30, 1937

This report is released to provide data on the composition and characteristics of the relief population as of November 30, 1937.

The report is based upon the information contained in the NEW JERSEY RELIEF CENSUS which was prepared from the records in municipal relief offices and submitted to the Financial Assistance Commission by Local Relief Administrators.

Persons receiving benefits from the Division of Old Age Assistance, State Board of Children's Guardians and Blind Commission were included in the census when other persons in the case were receiving direct relief.

The findings resulting from the study of these cases are submitted on the accompanying tables, and will be summarized in a final report to be issued at a later date.

MUNICIPALITIES REPORTING THE CENSUS
AND CASES REPORTED

87.3% of the population (1930 census) of the State is contained in the municipalities which reported the Census.

A complete census was submitted by 409 of the 566 municipalities in the State, covering 47,748 cases, or 91.8% of the 51,991 cases on direct relief, as of November 30, 1937.

In the 157 municipalities not reporting the census, there were 4243 cases under care in November 1937. 1/

Of these cases, 3751 were carried by 57 municipalities participating in State funds, and

492 cases were carried by 100 municipalities not participating in State funds.
