Governor Whitman to Unveil Public Service Announcement Via Interactive Distance Learning Technology

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will illustrate interactive distance learning technology when she unveils a new anti-smoking public service announcement simultaneously to high school students at four different schools.

Gov. Whitman will be present at the River Dell High School in Oradell and will broadcast live to three satellite schools where members of her cabinet will host students. Participating high schools are Wood-Ridge High School, hosted by Health and Senior Services Commissioner Len Fishman; Mahwah High School, hosted by Secretary of State Carol Cronheim; and Hackensack High School, hosted by Education Commissioner Leo Klagholz.

The live broadcast at River Dell High School will begin promptly at 10 a.m. and no one will be admitted to the room once the program begins.
