

Lead Assistance Programs

The New Jersey Department of Community Affairs (DCA) has a variety of lead-based paint hazard assistance programs to assist eligible occupants in remediating and/or abatement lead-based paint hazards in pre-1978 one to four family residential units. NJDCA's lead assistance programs are the following:

- Federal Lead Remediation and Abatement Program (LRAP)
- State Lead-Safe Home Remediation Program
- State Single-Family Home Remediation Program

Eligible Applications: Submission of an application ([Lead Assistance Program Application](#)) to a designated community-based agency or municipality ([Lead Assistance Contact List](#))

You may qualify for help the lead assistance programs if you meet the following requirements:

- The property has presence of lead-based paint hazards;
- Your household income is within the [low-to-moderate income limits](#);
- You live in a 1 to 4-unit residential home built before 1978;
- The property is structurally sound.
