The New Jersey State Department of Education has established new procedures for extending contracts beyond the ending date. If you think you will not be able to complete your project by the ending date on your contract, you must contact Brian Goldsmith, Business Manager at the State Library, (609) 984-6714, at least two months before the ending date to request an extension. You will be required to submit a statement explaining why the contract should be extended and a Board Resolution authorizing the request for an extension. These documents, along with a new page one of the contract, must be submitted to the Department two weeks before the ending date of the contract. If these procedures are followed, there should be no problem extending the contract. No requests for extensions initiated after the ending date will be approved.

Library Development Aid-Public Library Videotape Collections

Amount Available:

\$40,000

Purpose:

To provide for the development and expansion of audio-visual public library services through the use of videotapes.

Eligible Projects:

Eligible projects are those which provide for the purchase and interlibrary loan of educational, informational and non-theatrical videos to public libraries. Maximum grant award is \$5,000.

Eligible Applicants:

Any library or organization providing audio-visual public library services who owns and circulates a videotape collection of at least 1,000 videotapes. Grantees must agree to include the bibliographic data on all videotapes pur chased on the OCLC database.

Priority for Award:

An application must achieve a total average score of 65 points or more to be eligible for funding. Applicants will be funded in rank order, highest to lowest, to the extent of funds available.
