Aviation Department

The COVID-19 crisis continues to affect our region's domestic and international air passenger traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 75.7 percent year-over-year in the month of November – down 8.1 million travelers. Accounting for over 75 percent of the region's total air traveler volume, the domestic sector recorded a 71.8 percent plunge – down 5.138 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 83.1 percent – down 3.022 million travelers. Driven by the international sector's ninth straight monthly double-digit decline (-18,708 short tons/-15.9 percent), the region's total air freight volume fell 1.9 percent (-3,448 short tons). Domestic cargo was far more resilient, recording growth of 82,568 short tons (+22.7 percent), as JFK, EWR, and SWF grew their domestic cargo traffic by jointly handling 15,261 additional short tons compared to November 2019.
