Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily)" refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

THE PORT AUTHORITY OF NY & NJ FEBRUARY 2007 TRAFFIC REPORT

Aviation Department

Regional passenger traffic grew 3.7% on a 4.4% seat capacity rise. International growth led domestic by 8.0% to 2.2%. Regional growth bettered the American Transport Association (ATA) member airline 0.1% growth average, split between a 0.1% domestic and 0.7% international gain. Regional freight declined (1.0%) with international freight gaining 3.7% while domestic declined (6.7%). Mail jumped 22.6% -- mostly reflecting the FedEx and UPS practice of counting mail as freight.
