[New Jersey's Digital Equity plan](#) is posted for public comment through **November 30**. Public libraries show up prominently in the plan as assets available that assist with broadband access, device access and digital literacy.

Similarly, the [Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment \(BEAD\)](#) Initial Proposal is available for public comment. Volume 1 **until Nov. 21**, and Volume 2 **until Dec. 8**. Public libraries are included as community anchor institutions and, if funding is still available after addressing the state's first priorities, may be considered for upgrades to achieve gigabit internet speed.
