PART I - Where The Money Comes From

INTRODUCTION

Each year the State Chamber's Department of Governmental and Economic Research makes a detailed analysis of New Jersey's local property tax including a report on "where the money comes from" and "where the money goes."

Part II of the 1960 analysis, "where the money goes," was published earlier this year. It deals with the purposes for which the tax is levied, giving for the State, for each county, and for each municipality, the distribution of the property tax according to the amount levied for school purposes, for county purposes, and for municipal purposes; it also shows for each municipality the actual property tax rate, the average real property assessment ratio, and the effective real property tax rate.

The present study is Part I of the 1960 analysis; it tells the story of "where the money comes from." It deals with the sources of the property tax and shows for the state, for each county, and for each municipality, the impact of the property tax on the several categories of property and property taxpayers. The types of property for which data are presented are business real property, business inventories, and business machinery and equipment, farm real property, farm stock and machinery, Class II railroad property, vacant land, residential real property, and household goods.

A comparison of the statewide data in the State Chamber's 1959 report with the corresponding 1960 figures contained in this report yields the results found in the table on the next page.

As indicated in the table, in 1960 the local property tax in New Jersey totals \$834.7 million, an increase of \$61.5 million over 1959's \$773.1 million. The residential property tax in 1960 totals \$432.7 million, or 51.8% of the overall local property tax. The remaining 48.1% may be ascribed to "business" property taxes, i.e., taxes on property in which investment has been made primarily in the expectation of receiving a profit. This includes the types of property usually designated in New Jersey as "business property" (i.e., industrial, commercial, and apartment houses of more than 4 families), and, in addition, farm property, Class II railroad property, and vacant land.

Whatever concept of "business property" may be employed, the study shows the important role played in each municipality in the state by such property in providing for the support of schools and the other municipal and county services. The data in the report make possible ready comparisons among municipalities of the extent to which they have attracted and retained business which shares with homeowners the impact of the property tax.

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GENERAL NOTES TO TABLES

The following notes are provided to acquaint the reader with the sources of the basic data utilized in the preparation of this study and the assumptions adopted for the treatment of certain of those data.

SOURCES OF DATA

Total Taxes

Data presented for total tax levies (Col. 2) are taken from the several County Abstracts of Tax Ratables and Exemptions for 1960.

Taxes on Personalty and Class II Railroad Property

Data presented for taxes on business inventories (Col. 4), business machinery and equipment (Col. 5), farm stock and machinery (Col. 8), Class II railroad property (Col. 10), and household goods (Col. 13) have been computed from the assessed valuations appearing in the several County Abstracts. Similarly, the tax value of veterans' exemptions (Col. 14) have been computed from the amount of such exemptions appearing in the County Abstracts.

Taxes on Classes of Real Property (except railroad)

Data presented for taxes on real property--business (Col. 3), farm (Col. 7), vacant land (Col. 11), and residential (Col. 12)--have been computed from data on the assessments on each of the four classes of real property assembled by the Department of the Treasury's Local Property Tax Bureau in the process of preparing the State Table of Equalized Valuations for 1960.

ASSUMPTIONS

Business Real Property Taxes

The data on taxes on business property (Col. 3) have been computed from assessment data compiled by the Local Property Tax Bureau. That agency includes within this class of real property, property used for commercial purposes, that used for industrial purposes, and that used for apartment purposes where such apartments house more than four families.

Class II Railroad Property Taxes

The data presented in Column 10 are for the State assessed, locally taxed, Class II railroad property only

and do not include the taxes on Class I and Class III railroad property which are for State use. Such Class I and Class III railroad property taxes total \$2.5 million in 1960.

In assaying railroad property taxes, it should be borne in mind that property owned by the railroads, but not used for railroad purposes, is assessed and taxed as ordinary property and that taxes on such property are not reflected in data on the taxes paid on the three classes of property used for railroad purposes.

Residential Real Property Taxes

Data on taxes on residential real property (Col. 12) have been computed from assessment data compiled by the Local Property Tax Bureau. That agency defines such property as that being used for residential purposes by four families or less. Residential property used by more than one family is, in the main, income-producing property and as such, could, with considerable logic, be classed as business property. However, for the purposes of this study the Local Property Tax Bureau's classification has been adopted.

Taxes on Household Goods

The data for taxes on household goods (Col. 13) are shown net of the value of the \$100 basic exemption granted all householders.

Tax Value of Veterans' Exemptions

For the purposes of this study the tax value of veterans' exemptions (Col. 14) has been treated as a reduction of taxes levied against residential property, real and personal. Therefore, to the extent that such exemptions are actually claimed against non-residential property, taxes on such property are overstated and, conversely, taxes on residential property are understated.

In this treatment of veterans' exemptions, the study follows a convention with precedent in the Ninth Report of the Commission on State Tax Policy and in other published analyses of New Jersey's property tax. In any case this study shows the tax value of veterans' exemptions separately; thus making it possible to observe the residential property tax both with and without the veterans' exemptions.
