## SUPREME COURT OF NEW JERSEY

It is ORDERED that, pursuant to <u>N.J.S.A.</u> 43:6A-13, **Appellate Division Judge Joseph F. Lisa**, retired on pension and having given his consent, is hereby continued on recall by the Supreme Court for temporary service within the judicial system other than the Supreme Court for two years, effective September 4, 2014 or until further Order; and

It is FURTHER ORDERED that during this two-year recall continuation, Judge Lisa will remain temporarily assigned (a) to the Appellate Division of Superior Court as a settlement judge for the Civil Appeals Settlement Program (CASP) and to handle such administrative assignments as assigned by the Presiding Judge for Administration, and (b) as a member of special part to handle appeals from tier classification and notification determinations by the trial courts under the Registration and Community Notification Laws (N.J.S.A. 2C:7-1 et seq. (Megan's Law)).
