Gov. Whitman to Review Young Boot Camp Cadets in New Lisbon

Gov. Christie Whitman tomorrow will review the first class of graduating cadets from the military boot camp for youthful offenders in New Lisbon.

The Stabilization Re-integration Program boot camp for young adults is the first of its kind in New Jersey to house nonviolent male offenders between the ages of 18-26. The program is founded on the principles of military discipline, intensive physical work and substance abuse prevention and education. The program includes a strict orientation and qualification process as well as an extensive aftercare parole component.

The Governor will address the class of graduating cadets and discuss the importance of their continued self discipline and adherence to the parole aftercare program.
