NOTICE TO THE BAR

ONLINE ATTORNEY REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT – FINAL REMINDER – JULY 22 DEADLINE TO AVOID INELIGIBLE STATUS

Attorneys who have not completed the annual registration and payment process before July 22, 2019 will be declared ineligible to practice law by the Supreme Court and will be included in the list of ineligible attorneys that will be published on that date. <u>This notice serves as a final reminder of the July 22, 2019 deadline</u>.

Attorneys may complete their registration and payment by using the Judiciary's Attorney Online Registration and Payment Center at <u>https://www.njcourts.gov/attorneys/attreg.html.</u> The Center also can be accessed from the home page of the Judiciary website – njcourts.gov – by clicking on the "Attorneys" tab and then "Online Registration & Payment" under "Attorney & Judges Regulation." Attorneys are required to complete the registration, certify to the completion of CLE credits (if applicable) and the completion of pro bono requirements, and pay the annual assessment, including any late fees.

Additionally, as indicated in a number of prior notices to the bar, as part of the Judiciary's enhanced information security measures, all licensed New Jersey attorneys are now required to create a P-Synch profile. Creating that profile involves two steps: users (1) must select and answer three personal security questions, which will help with password recovery in the future, <u>and</u> (2) must select a password that is exactly eight characters long and contains at least one capital letter, one lower case letter, one numeral, and one of the enumerated special characters. To create your P-Synch security profile, go to the attorney portal on the Judiciary's website at <u>https://portal.njcourts.gov/webe3/sso</u> and click the "Click here for P-Synch" link.
