

**AUTHORIZATION FOR PLACEMENT
OF EMERGENCY QUARANTINES ON ACCOUNT OF
INFECTIOUS, TRANSMISSIBLE DISEASES OF LIVESTOCK**

Adopted August 1, 1952

In order to effectively control the spread of infectious, transmissible diseases of livestock, the State Board of Agriculture granted authority to the Director of the Division of Animal Industry to impose emergency quarantine where, in his judgment, such is required until such time as the State Board of Agriculture can meet and either ratify or remove the quarantine.

A report in writing shall be made to the Secretary of Agriculture within twenty-four hours of the placement of all quarantines giving the name and address of the owner and the disease for which the quarantine is placed.
