**RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES
MARCH 1996**

Comparing counts for March 31, 1996 with those on March 31, 1995, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

- 12% increase from 25,218 to 28,238 for all institutions;
- 12% increase from 24,561 to 27,432 for the adult jurisdictional population; (county waiting; county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);
- 30% increase from 3,647 to 4,751 for county waiting;
- 9% increase from 944 to 1030 for county contract and county assistance;
- 8% increase from 14,858 to 16,043 for the prison complex;
- 10% increase from 5,112 to 5,608 for the youth facilities; and
- 23% increase from 657 to 806 for the juveniles (juvenile facilities and juvenile waiting).

ADMISSIONS

- 1% increase from 1,473 to 1,483 for total admissions;
- -0% decrease from 1,369 to 1,367 for adults; and
- 12% increase from 104 to 116 for juveniles.

RELEASES

- 3% increase from 1,143 to 1,178 for total releases;
- -0% decrease from 794 to 793 for adult male parole releases;
- -20% decrease from 66 to 53 for adult female parole releases;
- -2% decrease from 860 to 846 for total adult parole releases;
- 16% increase from 237 to 276 for offenders discharged at max; and
- 22% increase from 46 to 56 for juvenile releases.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I—community, SL II—minimum, SL III—medium, SL IV—maximum and SL V—close.
- ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.
