

The DEP WEEKLY BULLETIN is an informational service provided free of charge by the N.J. Department of Environmental Protection. It contains a list of construction permit applications filed with or acted upon by D.E.P. Interested persons will thus be able to determine the status of applications dealing with Waterfront Development permits, Wetlands permits, Stream Encroachment permits, Sewerage Extension permits, and CAFRA permits (Coastal Area Facility Review Act). In addition the circular provides a calendar of Events of Interest and a Schedule of Public Hearings. (The Public Hearings however, are not official DEP notices). A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM"
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

I. STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. For further information contact the Bureau of Flood Plain Management, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

II. WATERFRONT DEVELOPMENT (609) - 292 - 0060

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor waterfront development projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact: Waterfront Development, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

III. SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) - 292 - 3846

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, siphons, gallorage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. For further information contact Division of Water Resources, P.O. Box CN029, Trenton, NJ 08625.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING
ATLANTIC COUNTY WATER QUALITY MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Atlantic County Division of Planning will hold a public hearing on Thursday, November 29, 1979 at Stockton State College, Room CC103, Pomona, N.J. The hearing will be held from 2:30-5 p.m. and 7 p.m. to 9 p.m., or until the end of testimony. The hearing topic is the Atlantic County Water Quality Management Plan prepared pursuant to Section 208 of the Federal Clean Water Act, as amended, 33 U.S.C. 1251 et seq. (Supp. 1978) and the New Jersey Water Quality Planning Act, N.J.S.A. 58-11A-1 et seq.

Copies of the draft plan will be available for review, 30 days prior to the hearing, at the Division of Water Resources, Office of Areawide Planning, 1474 Prospect Street, Trenton, N.J.; the Atlantic County Planning Division, Guarantee Trust Building, Atlantic City, N.J.; the Atlantic Community College Library, Mays Landing, N.J.; Stockton State College Library, Pomona, N.J.; Atlantic County Library, Pleasantville, N.J.; and the Hammonton Public Library, Hammonton, N.J.

Subsequent to the public hearing, the Plan will be submitted to the Governor and Regional Administrator of Region II of the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for review and adoption as the official Water Quality Management Plan for Atlantic County, pursuant to the authority of N.J.S.A. 58:11A-5 and in accordance with 40 CFR 35.1523-1 et seq.

Interested persons may present either oral or written comments at the public hearing. Written comments will also be accepted by the Atlantic County 208 office thirty (30) days after the public hearing date. Written comments should be submitted to:

DEP RECAP

(Recent press releases in capsule form)

November 8--PINELAND PLANNING MONEY ASSURED--Governor Brendan Byrne announced that the U.S. House and Senate Conferees restored \$200,000 in federal planning money to an appropriation totaling \$12 million for Pinelands preservation. Both House and Senate subsequently approved the Conference report. DEP Commissioner Jerry Fitzgerald English cited efforts of New Jersey Congressmen Frank Thompson, Jr., Joseph G. Minish and James J. Florio in securing the planning money, which had been in dispute. The appropriation awaits the signature of President Jimmy Carter.

November 13--CAFRA PERMIT IN OCEAN COUNTY--DEP conditionally approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for Countrywide Development Corporation to build 97 single-family houses on 51 wooded acres on Route 37 in Manchester Township, Ocean County. The permit is conditional on cessation of all development in southwest corner of the project, defined as a stream corridor.

November 13--ROLLINS ADVISORY GROUP TO REPORT--The Rollins Environmental Assessment Advisory Group will reveal recommendations early in December. The group was named to assure that all public questions regarding operation of the Rollins Environmental Services hazardous waste disposal facility in Logan Township, Gloucester County, will be addressed in its environmental impact statement.

November 14--AMENDMENTS PROPOSED TO UPDATE SCORP--Amendments to update the 1977 New Jersey Statewide Comprehensive Outdoor Recreation Plan are being proposed by DEP, according to Commissioner English. Developments in Pinelands protection, a priority system for acquisitions, additions to the Natural Areas System and urban waterfront plans are among factors to be updated. Public meetings will be November 29 at Stockton State College, Pomona, and December 4 at Parsippany High School, Vale Road, Parsippany.

November 14--RADIATION ASSESSMENT AT SITE IN ORANGE--DEP's Bureau of Radiation Protection has completed a preliminary assessment of radiation hazards at the site of a former radium watch dial painting operation at Aiden and High streets in Orange, Essex County. Still to undergo extensive scientific review, the draft report found no threats to passersby and nearby residents, but indicates possible high exposure levels to radon gas and gamma rays for those on the premises more than 40 hours per week.

November 15--TOWNSHIP PENALIZED FOR INADEQUATE SEWAGE TREATMENT--DEP's Division of Water Resources has notified Haddon Township, Camden County, that it will be assessed \$7,570 in an administrative penalty for inadequate sewage treatment at its Coles Mill Road plant and collection system.

November 15--CAFRA PERMIT FOR ATLANTIC CITY SEWERAGE ADDITION--DEP has approved a CAFRA permit for 7,780 linear feet of sewer lines of the Atlantic City Sewerage Company to upgrade service in the area bounded by the Boardwalk, and Florida, Pacific and Michigan avenues.

November 15--HAZARDOUS WASTE ADVISORY COMMISSION REPORT--A draft report by the Advisory Commission on Hazardous Waste, named recently by Governor Byrne, will undergo a public hearing December 7 at 2 p.m. in Hickman Hall, Douglas College Campus, Rutgers University, New Brunswick. A public meeting of the Commission to weigh earlier comments will be held November 26 at 4 p.m. in the Middlesex County Administration Building, New Brunswick.
