A UNIQUE SERVICE FOR NEW JERSEY INDUSTRY

Pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order # 57 the Office of Business Advocacy as staff to the Commissioner of Labor & Industry is charged with the responsibility of implementing a program of Permit Coordination on a state and local level. OBA provides assistance in guiding the applicant through the permit maze. OBA's technical staff function as expeditors in resolving the unexpected problems encountered when constructing a project.

The Office of Business Advocacy will designate a Permit Expediter to your project. The Permit Expediter will:

- A. Advise you of what DEP permits are required for your project, upon completing "MASTER PERMIT INFORMATION APPLICATION FORM".
- B. Coordinate contacts with relevant local and state regulatory agencies upon request.
- C. Monitor the progress of your permit application.
- D. Act to ensure processing of most permits within 90 days of application.
- E. Process "Over The Counter" certain permits meeting appropriate criteria.

## OVER-THE-COUNTER PERMITS

### STREAM ENCROACHMENT (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP now has a one-day processing service for certain minor stream encroachment permits. This "over-the-counter" service is limited to minor projects which do not adversely change the water carrying capacity of the floodway, do not increase erosion or sedimentation in the stream, and do not require substantial channel modification or relocation. ### RIPARIAN (609) - 292 - 2613

DEP has a one-day processing service for minor Riparian projects. This over-the-counter service applies to waterfront construction activity in man-made lagoons and minor maintenance and/or repair or replacement of lawful existing structures. For further information contact Riparian Lands Management, P.O. Box 1889, Trenton, NJ 08625.

### SEWER EXTENSIONS (609) 292 - 0700, or (609) - 292 - 4869

DEP has a one-day processing service for "minor" sewer extension projects. Eligible projects must meet certain criteria, such as, length of 1000 linear feet or less, cost of \$25,000 or less, sewage flow per day of 12,000 gallons or less. No projects with pump stations, force mains, syphons, gallonage transfers or holding tanks will be processed over-the-counter. Projects can not be located in areas under sewer ban, administrative orders, or litigation.

Projects must be in-house by 9:30 a.m., and all administrative documents must be in proper order. Pre-application conferences are strongly recommended. Appointments for over-the-counter processing should be arranged through the Office of Business Advocacy (below). For further information contact:

Feb. 20--O'HERN SPEAKER AT SEMINAR--DEP Commissioner Daniel J. O'Hern will speak Feb. 21 in Newark at a seminar on monitoring and controlling toxic pollutants which enter publicly owned sewage treatment plants.

Feb. 20--DEADLINE FOR PRESERVATION GRANTS--Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson, state deputy historic preservation officer, reminded the public that March 15 is the deadline for filing applications for historic preservation grants in the 1980 fiscal year. Information is available from the Office of Historic Preservation, 109 W. State Street, Trenton 08625. The telephone number is (609) 292-2023.

Feb. 22--CAFRA APPROVAL FOR SOMERS POINT SUBDIVISION--DEP approved a Coastal Area Facility Review Act (CAFRA) permit for a proposed 55-lot subdivision, "Patcong Woods," in the Cedar Springs area of Somers Point, Atlantic County. The applicant, Patcong Woods, Inc., redesigned the project to preserve more trees and provide a natural buffer to receive stormwater and protect wetlands. Houses adjacent to wetlands will have compatible natural colors.

Feb. 22--THREE SITES ADDED TO REGISTER OF HISTORIC PLACES--Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson announced that three sites have been added to the State Register of Historic Places and are being nominated for the National Register. They are the James Townley House in Union Township and the Orville Waring House/Runyon Funeral Home in Plainfield, both Union County, St. Nicholas Roman Catholic Church, Passaic.

Feb. 22--THREE SEWERAGE GRANTS TOTAL \$1.8 MILLION--Governor Brendan Byrne announced three grants through Clean Water Acts funds administered by DEP. Awards are dependent on outcome of current litigation on the use of bond funds. They are: Mount Holly Sewerage Authority, Burlington County, \$1.08 million to upgrade and expand the treatment plant. Dover Sewerage Authority, Ocean County, \$758,464 for wastewater collection system east of the Toms River and west of Hooper Avenue. Roxbury Township, Morris County, \$2,000 to prepare a wastewater facilities plan for a collection system in the Landing-Shore Hills area.

Feb. 23--O'HERN APPROVES RIVER DIVERSIONS FOR POTABLE WATER--DEP Commissioner Daniel J. O'Hern approved maximum daily diversions of 250 million gallons from the Passaic River at its juncture with the Pompton River, and 50 million gallons from the Ramapo River at Pompton Lakes. Water will enter systems of the North Jersey District Water Supply Commission and the Hackensack Water Company to augment supplies for a wide area in Northeastern New Jersey.

Feb. 22--FIVE RESOURCE RECOVERY GRANTS TO NEW JERSEY--Governor Byrne announced that five applicants in New Jersey will receive federal grants for resource recovery projects. Exact grant amounts will be negotiated with the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). Recipients, and requested grant amounts, are: Hackensack Meadowlands Development Commission, \$174,275 for planning toward 2,500-3,000 ton-per-day recovery facility; Port Authority of New York and New Jersey, with Essex and Hudson counties, \$971,000 for feasibility study on energy recovery in proposed industrial parks; City of Newark, \$216,701 to extend source separation program of Newark Recycling, Inc., a non-profit organization, to wider city areas; Mercer County, \$445,165 for feasibility study of newspaper source separation and steam energy recovery program at Homasote Company plant in West Trenton, and Camden County and City of Camden, \$250,000 to study energy recovery facility and source separation program in Camden. EPA also announced a \$500,000 grant to the City of Elizabeth to study new ways of meeting clean air requirements while continuing urban development.

Feb. 23--PUBLIC MEETING ON PINELANDS ORDER--A public meeting to explain Governor Byrne's executive order for a moratorium on Pinelands development was scheduled for March 1 at Stockton State College, Pomona. Sean Reilly, DEP's Pinelands coordinator, was to open a Toms River office on Feb. 26 for the same purpose, it was announced.

Feb. 23--TASK FORCE FOR NEW BRUNSWICK HISTORIC STUDY--Deputy DEP Commissioner Betty Wilson announced establishment of a task force to review an application to nominate the Hiram Market Historic District in New Brunswick to the State and National Registers of Historic Places. It will make recommendations to Deputy Commissioner Wilson by May 1.
