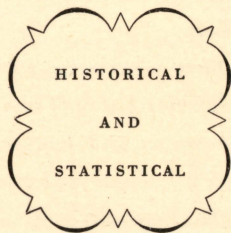

THIS booklet aims to supply in condensed form a register of our officers and members, with their addresses, occupations and interests.

The history of the club is contained in our hand book of 1920, copies of which may still be had. The club is nearly seventeen years old, has held a number of notable exhibitions, has issued nine books, all of excellence in matter and manner and now has two books in preparation for early issue.

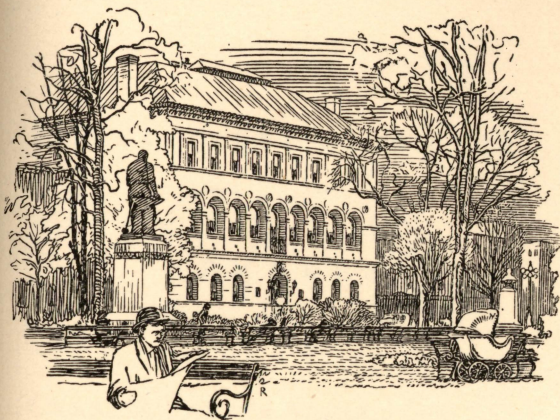

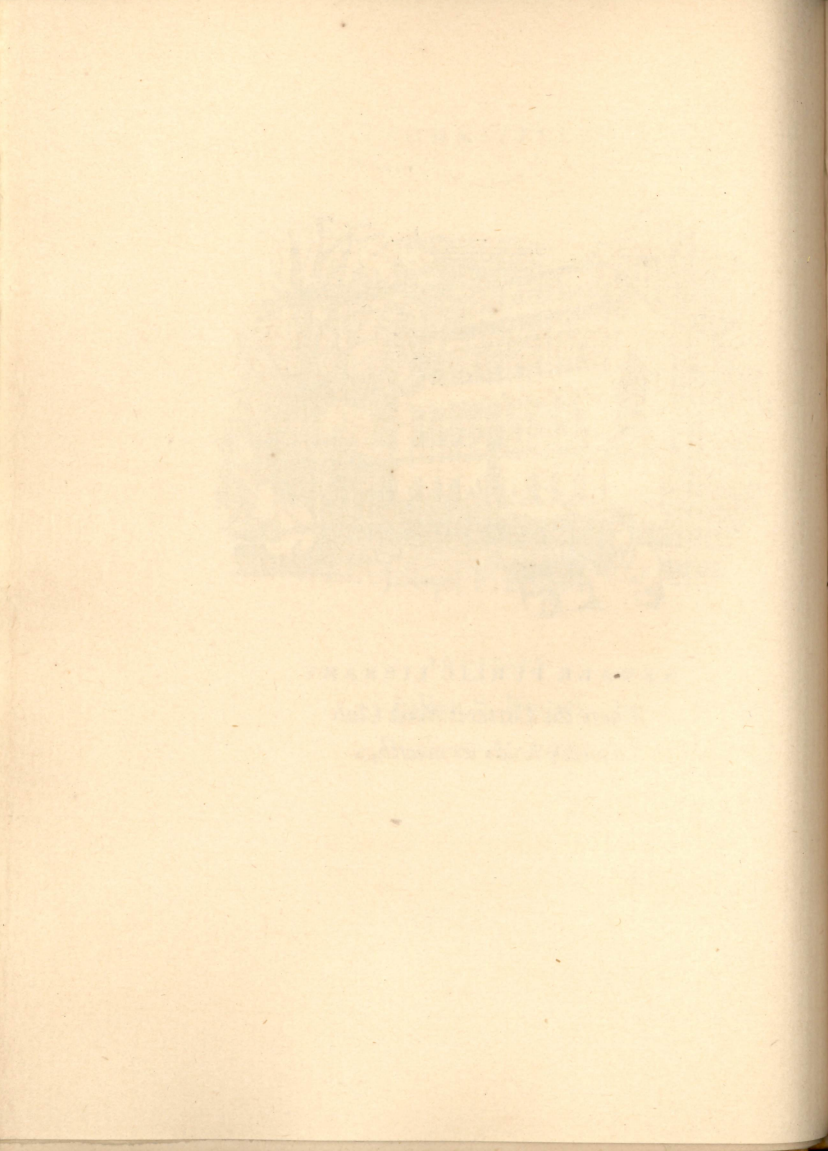

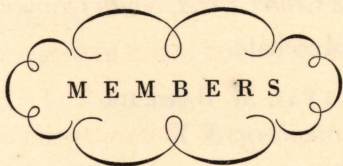
