Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline OAG summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

For the first time since January 2018's 1.6 percent dip, the region's total passenger volume contracted – down a modest 0.3 percent (-32,520 passengers). The domestic sector led the decline with a 1.5 percent drop (down 118,453 passengers), as carriers cut their domestic seat capacity by 1.3 percent. International passenger traffic bounced back from May's 0.7 percent dip (+1.8 percent/+85,933 travelers). Airlines increased their international seats by 2.9 percent, producing lower load factors. The region's total freight volume fell by 5.5 percent (-10,704 short tons). International cargo (over 60 percent of our region's total) led the slide with an 11.9 percent plunge (-14,964 tons). On the other hand, domestic cargo activity continues to grow solidly, achieving its fourth successive month of strong growth with a 6.7 percent jump (+4,509 tons).
