Trenton, NJ - Governor Chris Christie today signed Executive Order No. 157 renewing the New Jersey Hellenic-American Heritage Commission. The Commission was created in 2009 to recognize, study and promote Hellenic heritage, culture and history. The previous Executive Order establishing the Commission expired on June 11, 2014. Executive Order No. 157 renews the Commission until June 11, 2019.

"Americans of Hellenic ancestry contribute to the cultural, social, and economic strength of New Jersey," said Governor Chris Christie. "The dissemination of knowledge of the heritage, culture and history of Hellenes and Americans of Hellenic ancestry continues to be important to all New Jerseyans, and it is therefore appropriate for the Commission to continue its work for an additional period."
