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Comparing counts for November 30, 1998 with those on November 30, 1997, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

8% increase	from	27,965	to	30,286	for the jurisdictional population; (state inmates in county facilities, prison and youth complexes);
-8% decrease	from	3,984	to	3,651	for state inmates in county facilities;
15% increase	from	18,972	to	21,860	for the prison complex;
-5% decrease	from	5,009	to	4,775	for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

-5% decrease	from	1,256	to	1,198	for total admissions.
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RELEASES

-9% decrease	from	1,124	to	1,025	for total releases;
-36% decrease	from	776	to	496	for male parole releases;
26% increase	from	61	to	77	for female parole releases;
-32% decrease	from	837	to	573	for total parole releases;
29% increase	from	287	to	370	for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.

NOTE: Commencing April 1998 County Contract/Assistance and County Waiting figures are merged and reported as State Inmates in County Facilities.
