RESIDENTS, ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES

AUGUST 1997

Comparing counts for August 31, 1997 with those on August 31, 1996, the following changes are noted:

RESIDENTS

1% increase	from	27,118	to	27,485	for the jurisdictional population;
(county waiting, county contract, county assistance, prison and youth complexes);					
-26% decrease	from	4,561	to	3,365	for county waiting;
-4% decrease	from	1,036	to	991	for county contract & county assistance;
14% increase	from	15,968	to	18,219	for the prison complex;
-12% decrease	from	5,553	to	4,910	for the youth facilities.

ADMISSIONS

38% increase	from	940	to	1,298	for total admissions.
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RELEASES

-3% decrease	from	1,225	to	1,188	for total releases;
-11% decrease	from	888	to	793	for male parole releases;
10% increase	from	67	to	74	for female parole releases;
-9% decrease	from	955	to	867	for total parole releases;
19% increase	from	270	to	321	for offenders discharged at max.

NOTES: DEFINITIONS OF INMATES INCLUDED IN COUNTS

- a/ RESIDENTS include inmates in the institutions and on furlough on the last day of the reporting period. Past counts for major institutions may include the count for units that are no longer open. Housing security levels are designated as follows: SL I-community, SL II-minimum, SL III-medium, SL IV-maximum and SL V-close.
- b/ ADMISSIONS include commitments, parole returns for technical violation and prison and correctional returns from escape entered into the OBCIS database each month.
- c/ DISCHARGE AT MAX includes adult offenders released upon expiration of maximum sentence. Juvenile offenders are not included in this count.

REPORTING OF JUVENILE RESIDENTS ADMISSIONS AND RELEASES DATA has been discontinued. All juvenile offenders became the responsibility of the Juvenile Justice Commission, Department of Law and Public Safety as of July 1, 1996.
