**Trenton, NJ** – The Christie Administration announced today that the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has awarded a federal grant for \$1.6 million (with \$1.2 million FEMA share) to the New Jersey Department of Human Services (DHS) for emergency protective measures performed as a result of Superstorm Sandy.

The award provides federal funding to DHS for emergency protective measures to lodge out-of-state utility workers assisting in the restoration of power to New Jersey residents as a result of Superstorm Sandy.
