13:85-8.2 Schedule/registration

(a) The Office of Highway Traffic Safety shall publish a notice of the schedule of classes in the MRC/RSS, MRC/IRC, or MRC/ERC courses offered during a calendar year in the New Jersey Register and at least two newspapers with Statewide circulation at least one month prior to the start of classes. The schedule shall be made available to the public from the Office of Highway Traffic Safety upon request. The schedule shall include the times, dates and locations of the classes offered, any registration period, any registration fee imposed by the Director for each course and the means by which a person who is the holder of a valid New Jersey motorcycle operator learner's permit or valid New Jersey motorcycle license or endorsement may register. Classes shall be scheduled no earlier than March 1 and no later than December 31.

13:85-8.1 Courses

(a) The courses offered by Office of Highway Traffic Safety shall be those established by the Director pursuant to N.J.A.C. 13:85-1.3.

(b) The Director may impose a registration fee on participants if the monies available in the Motorcycle Safety Education Fund are insufficient to cover the costs of the program.

(b) Registration shall be on a form supplied by the Office of Highway Traffic Safety which shall set forth the qualifications for enrollment in the MRC/RSS, MRC/IRC, and MRC/ERC courses in accordance with N.J.A.C. 13:85-2.1.

(c) The Office of Highway Traffic Safety shall maintain an attendance roster for each class and a written record of each participant's performance in the course.

(d) Each participant shall complete a Release, Waiver, and Indemnification Statement which releases the State from any and all liability, loss, costs, claim and/or damage arising out of participation in any course conducted by the Office of Highway Traffic Safety.
