Aviation Department - Traffic Statistics

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Notes1: The section entitled Air Transport Association Carriers is included to give a comparison between Port Authority Airport traffic growth and aggregate growth as measured by the majority of the U.S. carrier industry.

Note2: The page 2 Access Mode: residents report excludes passengers arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other"

arriving by hotel courtesy vehicles, helicopters, and the miscellaneous "other" category. The airline ADI summary uses schedules effective for the week in the middle of the month being summarized. "Flights (daily) refers to the daily-each-way average flights which can be thought of as 1 directional departing or arriving flights.

The COVID-19 crisis continues to affect our region's domestic and international air passenger traffic. Total passenger volume sank by 82.1 percent year-over-year in the month of September – down 9.43 million travelers. Accounting for nearly 75 percent of the region's total air traveler volume, the domestic sector recorded a 78.5 percent plunge – down 5.589 million passengers. International passenger activity fell by 88.1 percent – down 3.839 million travelers. Driven by the international sector's seventh straight monthly double-digit decline (-22,031 short tons / -12.3 percent), the region's total air freight volume fell 12.3 percent (-22,031 short tons). Domestic cargo was far more resilient, recording growth of 13,819 short tons (+20.8 percent), as JFK, EWR, and SWF grew their domestic cargo traffic by jointly handling 13,974 additional short tons compared to September 2019.
